ORDER IMPOSING MONETARY SANCTIONS

THIS CONSTITUTES NOTICE OF ENTRY AS REQUIRED BY FRCP, RULE 77(d).

The court has read "Plaintiff's Notice of Defendants Zhuang and Emerald's Non-Compliance With The Civil Contempt Order," including the Declaration of Jamie A. Brown. The Court has also read the "Reply of Defendants Emerald Worldwide Holdings, Inc., and Jian Zhuang to Plaintiff's Notice of Non-Compliance With Civil Contempt Order," including the purported declaration of Jian Zhuang, which is defective in form. The Court rejects those defendants' requests for additional time to comply with the Court's July 29, 2004 Civil Contempt Order ("the Contempt Order.").

The Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that Defendants Emerald Worldwide Holdings, Inc. ("Emerald") and Jian Zhuang ("Zhuang") have willfully failed to comply with the Contempt Order. The Court further finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that the following coercive sanctions, referred to in the Contempt Order, are necessary and the following Defendants therefore are hereby ORDERED to pay them:

- 1. Zhuang shall pay to the District Court a daily compliance fine of \$250.00. If, thereafter, Zhuang fails to pay such fine, the Court will entertain an application from the Commodity Futures Trading Commission for a writ of body attachment, arrest warrant or other comparable remedy.
- 2. Emerald shall pay to the District Court a daily compliance fine of \$200.00.

These fines become payable as of the date of this Order.
