The Court rejects those defendants' requests for additional time to comply with the Court's July 29, 2004 Civil Contempt Order ("the Contempt Order").

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
1 The Court finds, by clear and convincing evidence, that Defendants Emerald
2 Worldwide Holdings, Inc. ("Emerald") and Jian Zhuang ("Zhuang") have willfully
3 failed to comply with the Contempt Order. The Court further finds, by clear and
4 convincing evidence, that the following coercive sanctions, referred to in the
5 Contempt Order, are necessary and the following Defendants therefore are hereby
6 ORDERED to pay them:

- 7 1. Zhuang shall pay to the District Court a daily compliance fine of
8 \$250.00. If, thereafter, Zhuang fails to pay such fine, the Court will
9 entertain an application from the Commodity Futures Trading
10 Commission for a writ of body attachment, arrest warrant or other
11 comparable remedy.
- 12 2. Emerald shall pay to the District Court a daily compliance fine of
13 \$200.00.

14 These fines become payable as of the date of this Order.
