ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CBOE ACTION AGAINST LARRY A. DUBAN AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed the sanction of admonishment imposed by the CBOE on Larry A. Duban, of Chicago, Illinois, an Exchange member and registered market maker. The CBOE sanctioned Duban for violating the Exchange's position limit restrictions with respect to Teledyne options. The Commission found, as had the CBOE, that, on three occasions in 1981, despite having received notice of the applicable position limits, Duban purchased Teledyn contracts exceeding those limits. The Commission concluded that the light sanction imposed on Duban was not excessive, particularly in view of Duban's history of position limit violations. (Rel. 34-19871)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
