Color Values: Text - PMS 286 (100%); Burst - PMS 286 (40%)



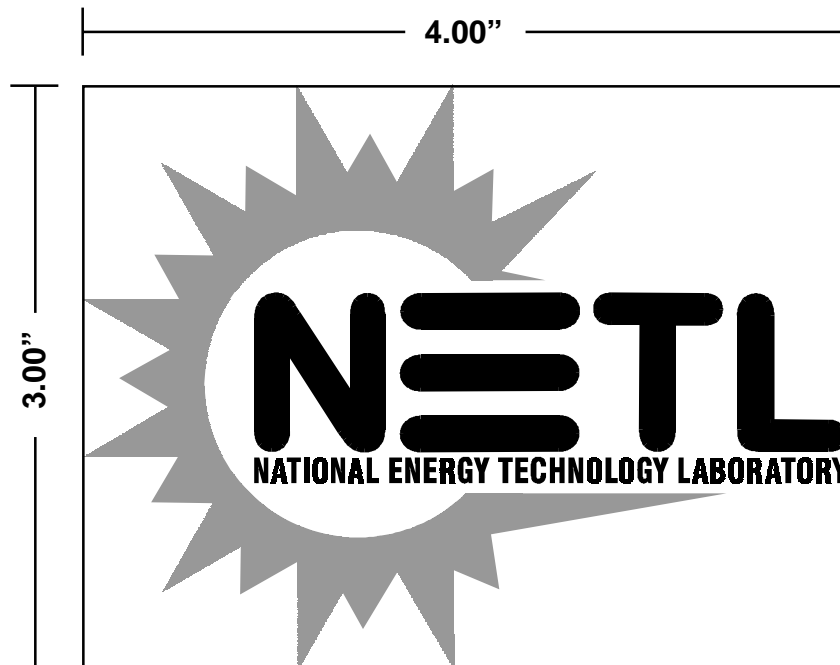
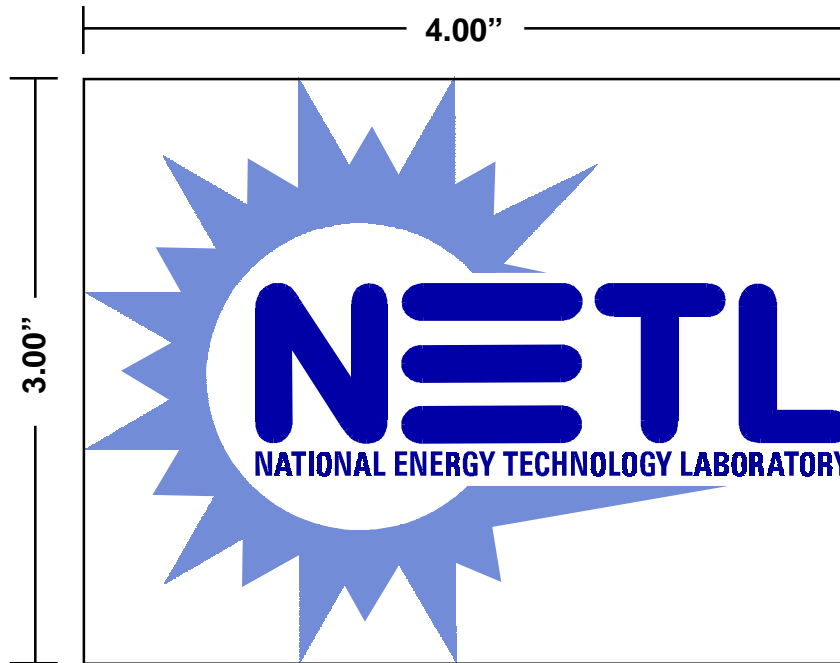
Black & White: Text - Black (100%); Burst - Black (40%)

As illustrated, the length of the NETL logo is .75 times the height. This relationship is always the same regardless of the reproduction size.

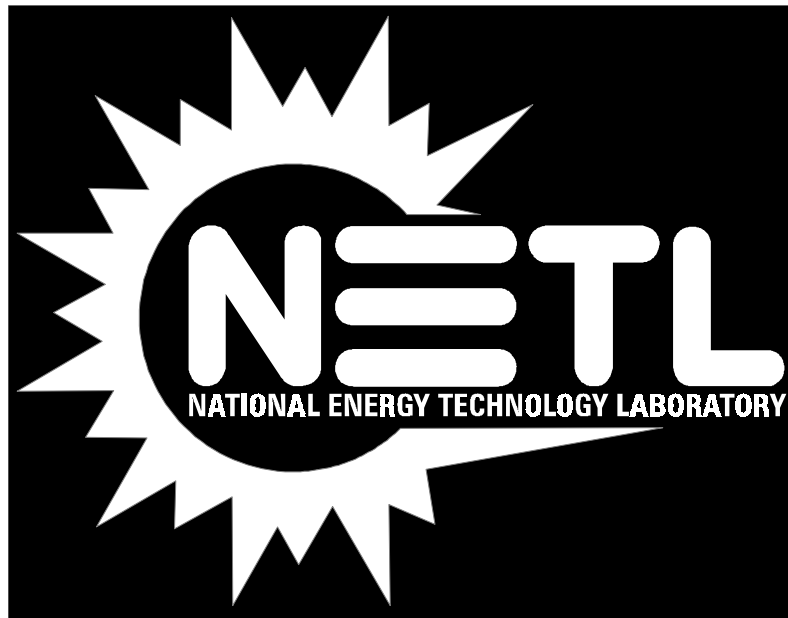

Logo

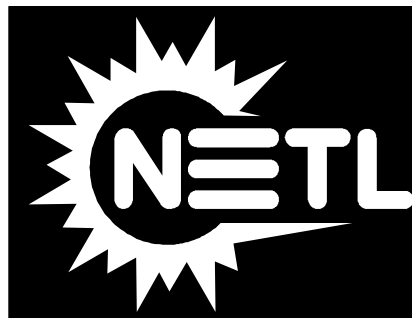
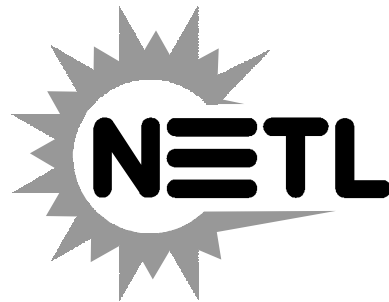
When the logo appears on a background equivalent to a 50% screen or darker, the logo can be reversed. When reversed, the result appears as illustrated.
