## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### WILLIAM J. GREGERMAN BARRED

In connection with a pending administrative proceeding, the Commission entered Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against William J. Gregerman, formerly an associated person of a registered broker-dealer in Houston, Texas. The Order was entered following an Offer of Settlement submitted by Gregerman wherein he consented, without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's September 28, 1988 Order for Proceedings, to certain findings and the sanctions imposed.

On the basis of the Order for Proceedings and the Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that in 1987 Gregerman was convicted, upon a plea of guilty, of two felony counts of making and subscribing false federal income tax returns for 1978 and 1979 in violation of Title 26, USC §7206(1) [U.S. v. William J. Gregerman, Docket No. CR-86-335, SDTX].

Based on the above findings and the Offer of Settlement, Gregerman was barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer, provided that he may apply to become associated in a non-proprietary and non-supervisory capacity after two years from the date of the Order. ### JEFFREY A. SADOWSKI BARRED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Jeffrey A. Sadowski under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneously, Sadowski submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Sadowski, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which find that he willfully violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Order also finds that Sadowski was enjoined from future violations of those provisions in SEC v. Powers & Sadowski, Inc., Thomas L. Powers, Jeffrey A. Sadowski, NDIL, Civil No. 87 C 3722, filed April 22, 1987.

Accordingly, the Commission barred Sadowski from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer for three years. (Rel. 34-26647)
