# CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES GARY VAN WAEYENBERGHE, OTHERS

The Commission filed a Complaint for Permanent Injunction and disgorgement on May 8 against Gary Van Waeyenberghe and Carl Leibowitz of South Bend, Indiana, and Howard K. Schwartz, an attorney residing in West Bloomfield, Michigan, charging them with violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The Complaint alleges that defendants participated in the offer and sale of limited partnership interests in three partnerships which were to engage in the ethanol business in Euless, Texas and Wanatah, Indiana. Despite representations to return the offering proceeds plus interest to investors if the offerings were not sold in accordance with the terms of the offering memoranda, defendants failed to honor these commitments and utilized some of the funds raised for purposes unrelated to the businesses of the partnerships. Each offering memorandum also contained numerous false and misleading statements concerning the general partner and the financing and management of the issuers. (SEC v. Gary Van Waeyenberghe, et al., Civil Action No. CA 4-89-376-E). (LR-12101)
