The Community Relations Service is requesting a program enhancement of \$2,350,000 to address racial violence, disorders and conflict in local communities. The enhancement would improve and expand delivery of conciliation and conflict resolution services to local jurisdictions with the addition of fifteen conciliation specialists ten intake specialists, and five support personnel. The additional funding will sustain CRS involvement in communities and will maintain ongoing relationships with local officials, law enforcement agencies, and civic leaders, especially during critical times of community unrest and disorder.
