

National Income and Product Accounts Tables

This set of tables presents the results of the annual revision of the national income and product accounts (NIPAs) released beginning July 28, 2006. The tables present revised annual estimates for 2003–2005, revised quarterly estimates for the first quarter of 2003 through the first quarter of 2006, revised monthly estimates for January 2003 through May 2006, and “advance” estimates for the second quarter of 2006 and for June 2006.
