Subcontractor Environment, Safety and Health Performance (5-99)

It is the policy of Lockheed Martin Energy Systems to award subcontracts only to firms that have demonstrated safety performance equal to or better than the industry average. In order to be considered for award, the offeror must have performance as follows:

- A three year average Interstate Experience Modification Rate (EMR) not to exceed ______. The offeror must submit this EMR on the letterhead of its Workers compensation Insurance carrier.
- A three year average Total Recordable Case rate (TRC) not to exceed ______ per 200,000 man hours. Offerors are to submit the form OSHA 200 for the past three calendar years.

The offeror must submit the form entitled, *Subcontractor Safety Qualification Questionnaire*, with its offer.

Offers received from firms which do not meet these minimum requirements will not be considered.

Note: The threshold statistical data is based on pre-determined industry classification codes which have been assigned to certain LMES subcontracted services. The values were derived from the most recent North American Industry Classification System (NAICS).
