SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS AND CHARTS — 1987

MOTOR FUEL - Highway Use of Gasoline up 1.8 Percent; Special Fuels (Diesel) Use up 3.4 Percent

Highway use of motor fuel in 1987 totaled 127.7 billion gallons, an increase of 2.0 percent from 1986. In 1988, highway use of motor fuel is expected to increase by about 3.1 percent. Net motor-fuel revenues increased 10.2 percent from 1986, reflecting a number of tax increases which took effect in late 1986 and in 1987 as well as increased motor-fuel consumption. Motor-fuel revenues are expected to increase by about 10.5 percent in 1988, reflecting additional tax rate increases in 1988 and a further increase in motor fuel consumption.

The increase in motor-fuel usage reflects a continued growth in travel and occurred despite an increase in the fuel efficiency of the vehicle fleet from 14.66 MPG in 1986 to 15.06 in 1987.

MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS - Total Motor-Vehicle Registrations Exceed 179 Million in 1987

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 175,700,214 in 1986 to 179,044,449 in 1987, an increase of 1.9 percent. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues increased 6.8 percent. Motor-vehicle registrations for 1988 are expected to exceed 1987 by 2.5 percent for a total of 183,468,000. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues are expected to increase 3.0 percent in 1988.

DRIVER LICENSING - Number of Licensed Drivers up 1.5 Percent

The total of 161.8 million licensed drivers in 1987 reflects an increase of 1.5 percent over 1986. This growth rate is expected to continue through 1988. Eighty-six percent of the Nation's driving age population (age 16 or over) is licensed to drive.

HIGHWAY FINANCE - Total Highway-User Imposts Increased by \$2.8 Billion in 1987

Highway-user imposts, consisting of motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls, increased \$2.8 billion from 1986 to 1987. These revenues totaled \$40.1 billion and accounted for 60.4 percent of total receipts for highways from all units of government in 1987. Total receipts were \$66.5 billion, an increase of slightly more than \$1 billion over 1986. Receipts from nonuser sources--general revenue, property taxes, investment income and miscellaneous receipts--totaled \$22.0 billion, a 5.0 percent increase from 1986. Bond proceeds for 1987 were \$4.4 billion, a decrease of \$2.5 billion from 1986.

Total highway expenditures amounted to \$66.3 billion in 1987, up nearly \$4 billion from 1986. Capital outlay increased \$1.8 billion, or 6.2 percent, to \$31.0 billion. Inflation in highway construction prices increased slightly in 1987 resulting in a net increase of 6.5 percent in highway capital outlay. Expenditures for highway maintenance and traffic services amounted to \$19.0 billion, an increase of \$1.3 billion, or 7.6 percent; however, inflation reduced real expenditures to a 3.4 percent increase over 1986.

For the 50 States and the District of Columbia, highway-user imposts accounted for 81.2 percent of the \$32.8 billion in State highway receipts for 1987. This is a significant increase from the 75.1 percent share for 1986. State highway receipts from user fees increased by \$2.3 billion while receipts from nonuser sources increased by only \$131 million. Nonuser sources accounted for 13 percent of State receipts for highways. Bond proceeds totaled \$1.9 billion, a drop of \$2.0 billion from 1986. Bond proceeds exclude refunding. State highway programs totaled \$39.6 billion (excluding grants-in-aid to local governments) for 1987, an increase of \$1.7 billion over 1986. Highway capital outlay--\$22.9 billion--accounted for 57.9 percent of total State expenditures, about the same as in 1986.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL - Travel up 4.9 Percent

Public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1987, totaled approximately 3.87 million miles, a decrease of 0.1 percent from 1986.


Highway travel in the United States increased to an estimated 1,924 billion vehicle-miles in 1987--an increase of about 4.9 percent from the previous year.

The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 22 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 71 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 87 percent of the travel.

MISCELLANEOUS - Expenditures per mile average \$25,180 and \$7,890 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance, respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle-miles of travel averaged \$15.64 for all States.


















HIGHWAY EXPENDITURES BY ALL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT









(EXCLUDING TOLL FACILITIES)




STATE HIGHWAY-USER REVENUE PER VEHICLE-MILE OF TRAVEL 1987
