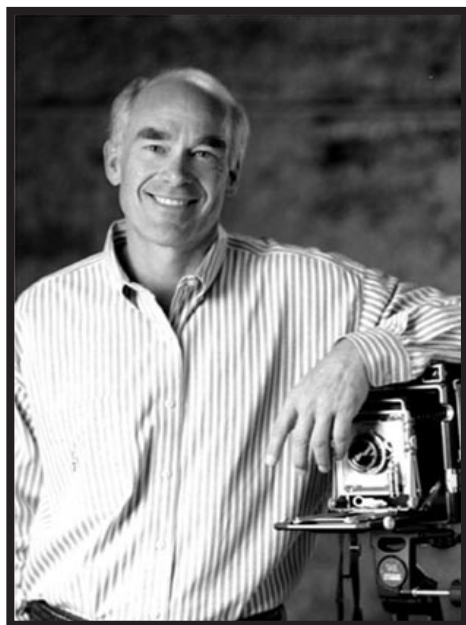


John Fielder

More than 15 years ago, John Fielder published his first book on Colorado's wilderness areas. Since then he has published many other books celebrating Colorado's wild places and open spaces. Fielder's commitment to preserve Colorado's natural landscape is undying. On this, the 40th Anniversary of the Wilderness Act, he has now published another magnificent tribute to Colorado's pristine wild areas, *Mountain Ranges of Colorado*.

Fifteen years in the making, these images were created on the most remote and strenuous backpacking excursions of Fielder's career. This tribute to Colorado's mountain ranges is a must for Fielder fans and lovers of the Colorado mountain experience. Jack Reed, a USGS geologist for 47 years, did most of the research and writing for this publication.
