

- Covered fleet
 - 10 or more vehicles
 - Capable of being centrally fueled
- Ozone or CO non-attainment area
- State administered program
- Start delayed from 1998 to 1999





What Is a Clean Fuel Vehicle?




- 1. LEV

Basic Cert Process




Projected Nox Emissions Benefit for HD CFF Engines

(Tons /Year)




Projected NMHC Emissions Benefit for HD CFF Engines


(Tons / Yr)

- Provide guidance to the states
- Work with manufacturers and fleets

Conversions

- Certified conversion configuration
 - Performed by
 - Aftermarket conversion certifier
 - Certificate holder
- Must meet CFF certification requirements
- Must meet I/M CO standards each vehicle

EPA / DOE Programs

- Clean fuel fleet - EPA
 - Must meet LEV or better
 - Fuel neutral
 - Up to 26,000lbs. GVWR
- Clean cities - DOE
 - Energy security
 - LDV & LDT only
