This employee, if injured during the performance of official duties, is entitled to medical, surgical and hospital services, and physical therapy for treatment of the injury, as well as transportation for obtaining care. These rights are covered under the Federal Employee Compensation Act, (5 U.S. Code 8101 et seq.) as administered by the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP) of the U.S. Department of Labor. If the claim is denied by OWCP, the employee may use his/her personal health insurance to cover treatment services and costs. Please accept this card, along with the APHIS Identification card, of the employee's right to treatment.

ATTENTION MEDICAL PERSONNEL

This employee is likely to be exposed to pesticides and certain zoonotic diseases which are not routinely considered in the differential diagnosis of febrile illnesses. APHIS requests that you consider pesticide poisoning and the following diseases in case of serious illness in this individual:

Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, Anthrax, Monkeypox, Q Fever, Hantavirus, Plague, Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, Leptospirosis, Tularemia, Lyme Disease, Brucellosis, Typhus, Arbovirus Encephalitis (Eastern, Western, St. Louis, California), Giardiasis, Histoplasmosis, Psittacosis, Spirochaetal Relapsing Fever, Bovine Tuberculosis, and West Nile Virus.
