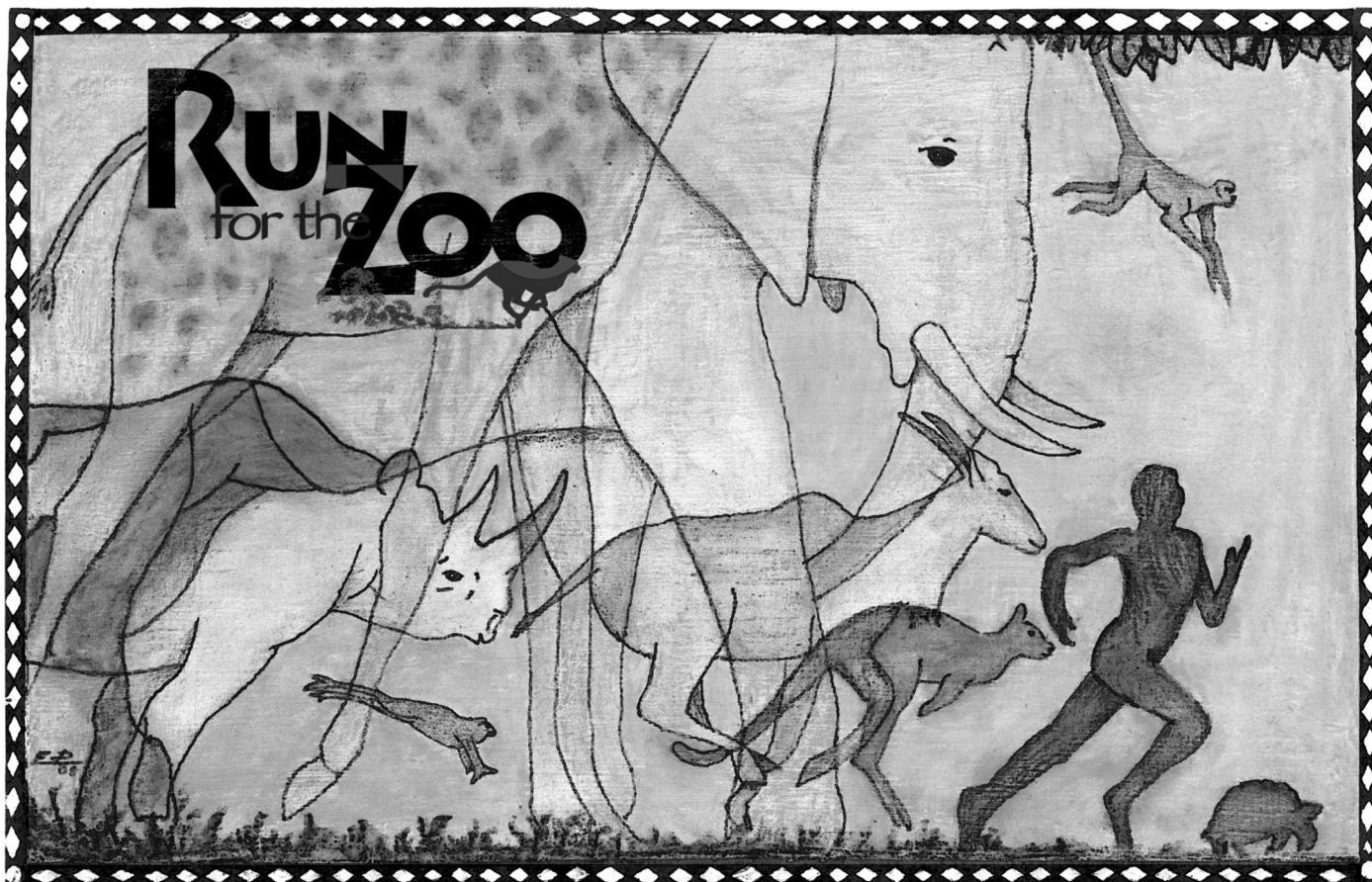


# Parking Information

- 10th Street is part of the race course and will be closed. Coal and Iron between 8th and 10th will also be closed. Enter the Downtown area from Central using streets east of 8th (6th Street, 4th Street)
- Street parking will be available North of Coal and East of 10th, and any streets east of 8th. Parking Meters are FREE on Sundays! Please observe parking ordinances. Do not block residents' driveways. Watch for No Parking Zones. Parking violators will be ticketed and/or towed.
- Several parking lots are available in the Downtown area (see map on back). Some will be free to participants, some are Pay for Parking lots. Vehicle owner assumes all risk and/or liability.
- Park-n-Ride will be available at the Rio Grande Botanic Garden and Albuquerque Aquarium at 2601 Central NW. First pick-up is at 6:00 a.m. Shuttle service ends at 1:00 p.m.

**Street Parking and Downtown Parking Lots are the best options for the two early races ( 7:00 a.m. 10k and 8:30 a.m. Timed 5k). Try parking Downtown first. You may get closer to the race course and there's no waiting for the bus.**

## **PARK-N-RIDE**

**WHERE:** Albuquerque Biological Park  
2601 Central NW.

**WHEN:** From 6:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.  
First pick-up is at 6:00 a.m.  
Be at 8th and Silver no later than 1:00 p.m.  
for the last drop-off.

- Enter at the North Lot at the New York entrance off Central unless otherwise instructed.
- Busses will take participants to 8th and Silver; then it's a short "warm-up" walk to the Start Line at 8th and Atlantic.
- If using Park-n-Ride, please arrive at the Aquarium at least one hour before your race starts.
- Parking space is limited. Lots will be closed when full. Parking ordinances will be enforced.
- Drop off's can be made at 8th and Silver or Downtown outside the race course. School groups and other large groups should plan designated meeting areas. **Do not drop off race participants at the Aquarium.**
- Return service from 8th and Silver back to the Aquarium ends at 1:00p.m.

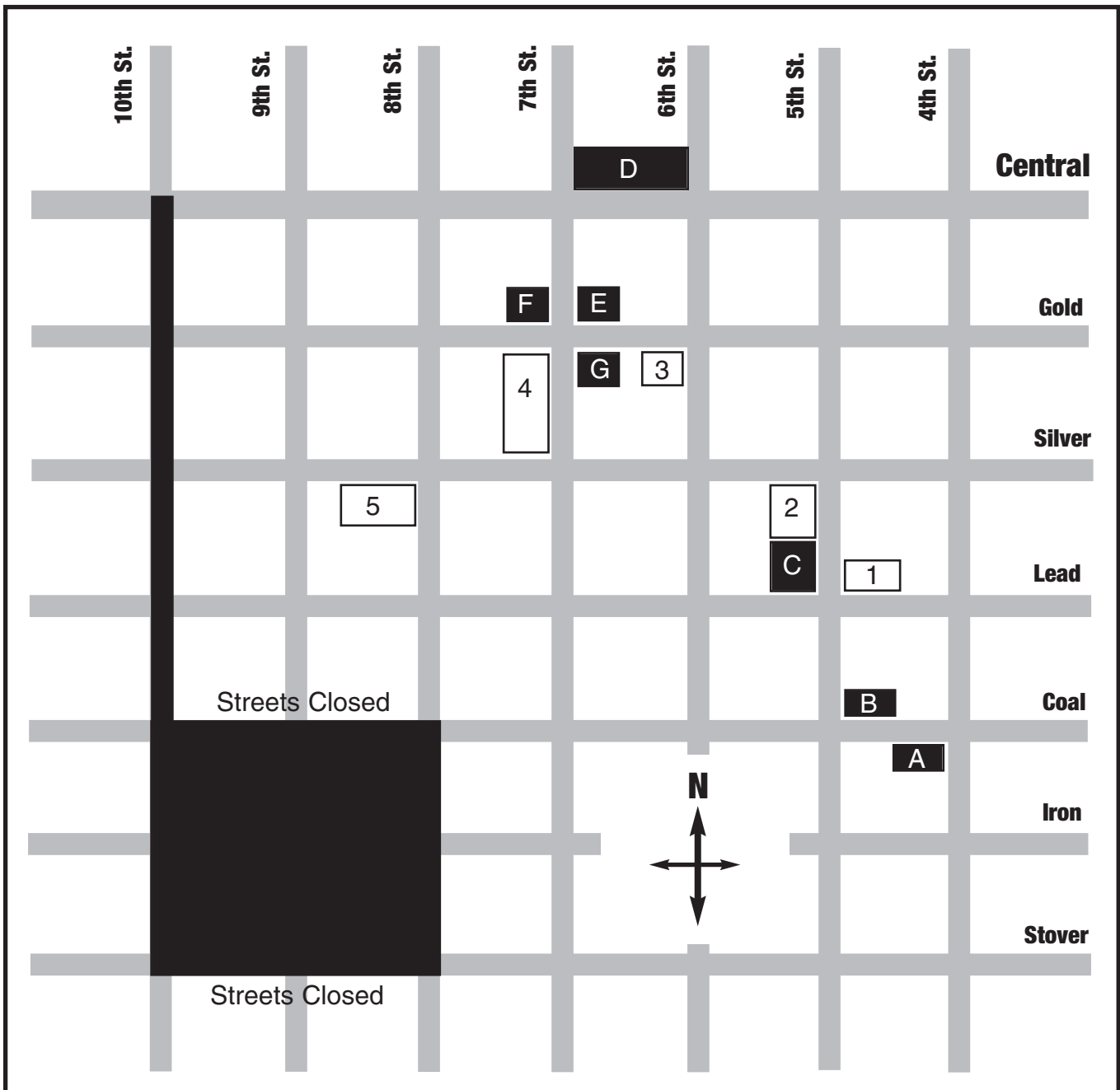
**FREE PARKING LOTS**

- 1.) NE corner 5th & Lead - Behind PNM building.
- 2.) SW corner 5th & Silver - Across from PNM building.
- 3.) SW corner 6th & Gold (Silver Square permit parking).
- 4.) West side of 7th between Silver & Gold (Silver Square large monthly permit lot).
- 5.) SW corner 8th & Silver across from Flying Star - donated by Infill Solutions

**PAY PARKING LOTS**

- A.) SW corner 4th & Coal - \$1.50
- B.) NE corner 5th & Coal - \$1.75
- C.) NW corner 5th & Lead behind Cafe - \$2.50
- D.) NW corner 6th & Central - \$3.00
- E.) NE corner 7th & Gold - \$2.00
- F.) NW corner 7th & Gold - \$2.00
- G.) SE corner 7th & Gold behind USNM FCU - \$2.00 All Day

Some street parking is available on Lead, Silver, Gold, 7th, 6th, and 5th. **Parking meters are free on Sundays. Observe parking ordinances as they will be enforced.** Coal and Iron will be barricaded at 8th, 9th, and 10th. 10th St. will be completely closed. These streets are part of the race course. **Absolutely NO PARKING on the SW corner of 6th and Silver.**
