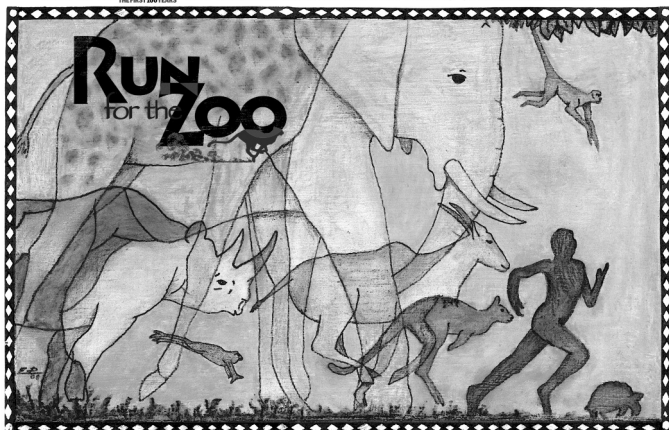

Where are the water stations?

Water is available on the course and at the front of the Zoo.

What if I want to change events?

Go to the troubleshooting table at the packet pick-up/registration area.

Where can I store my stuff?

At "Runner Gear Storage" on Atlantic.

What if a runner needs medical help?

Paramedics are stationed at the Finish Line for dispatch as needed. Race volunteers are wearing specially colored event shirts with "Zoo Crew" on the back. Please ask for help and report any incident. Police, volunteers, and paramedics can be reached by radio.

Spectators may not cross 10th Street in front of the Finish line or through the chip collection area. Crossing is permitted ONLY on the south side of Tingley Field.

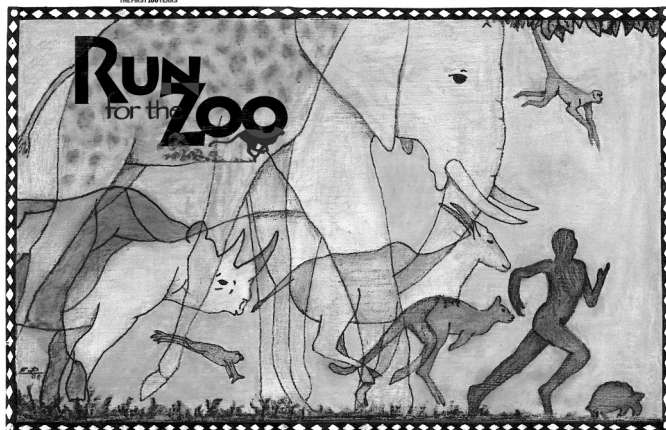
Handicapped Access - The course is closed to ALL vehicular traffic. Handicapped parking is available at the Albuquerque Aquarium. From there, take the FREE Park & Ride bus to 8th and Silver. This is as close to the course as you will be able to get. It is about five blocks from the Start Line.

Your race bib is your Zoo Admission for the day. If you do not wish to register for an event, to get into the Zoo you must purchase an admission ticket.

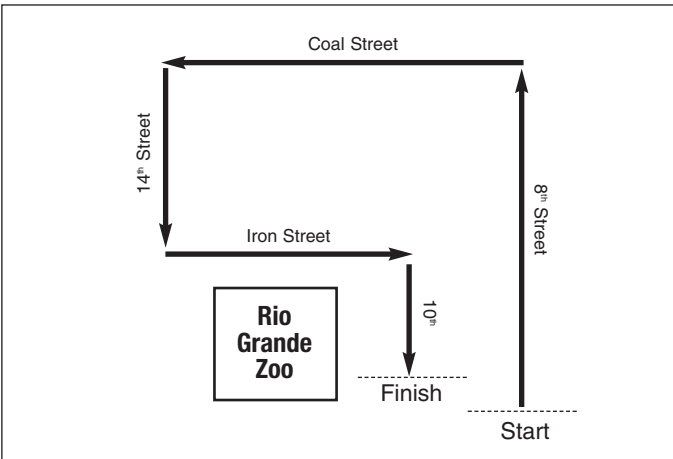
