
The Census of Fatal Occupational Injuries uses a variety of sources to document and verify cases of work-related fatal injury. In 2004, over 20,000 source documents helped identify and verify information on 5,764 fatal work injuries.

At least 25 different types of source documents may be utilized by States seeking information on worker fatalities.
