No Child Left Behind Empowers Families With Options

When a child's school has been identified as "in need of improvement" by the state in which it is located, one option a family has is to choose a better-performing public school or a public charter school.

Another option is for the student to receive free tutoring and after-school help. Called "supplemental educational services" under NCLB, they are available to qualified low-income students.

Your child may be eligible for school choice or supplemental educational services.
