

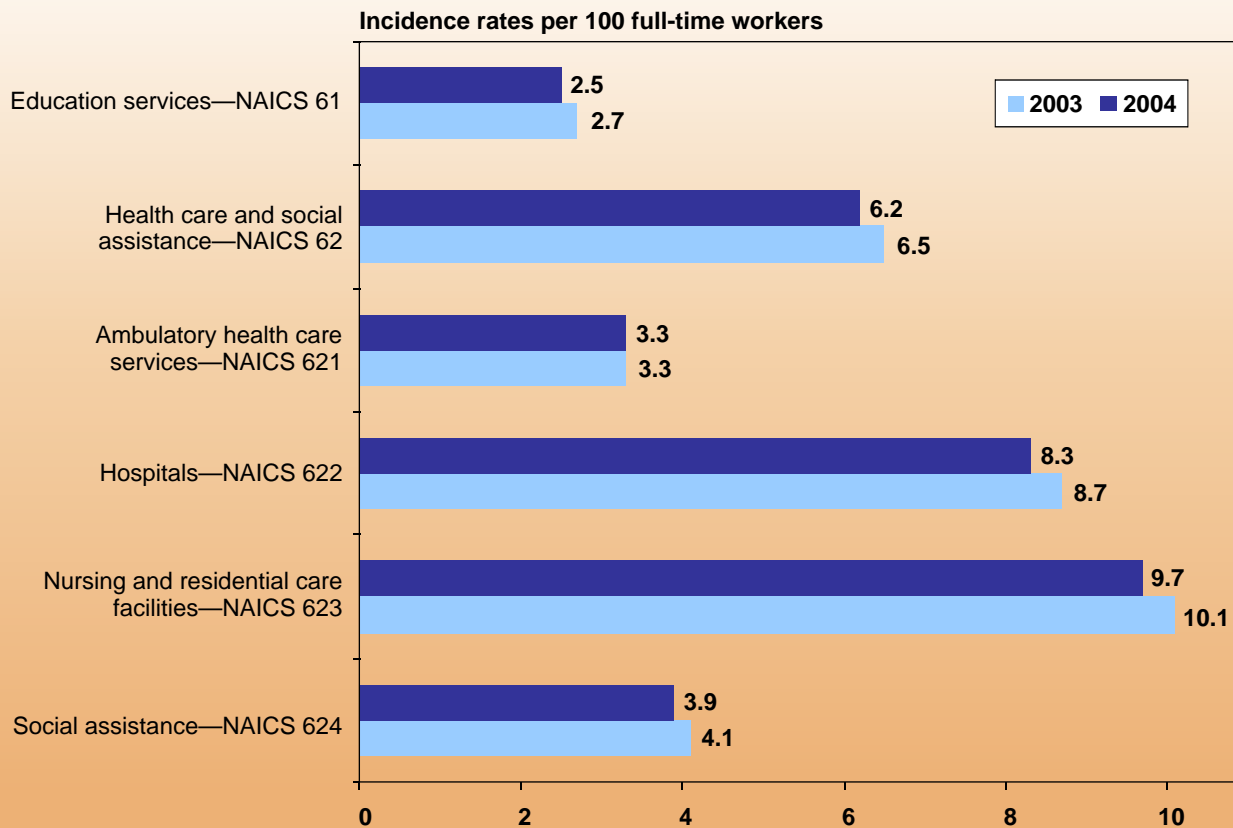
Within the education and health services major industry sector, the rate of injuries and illnesses for health care and social assistance was more than 2 times higher than the rate for education services in 2004.

Of the 4 three-digit NAICS industries within health care and social assistance, 3 were among the 14 industries reporting 100,000 or more cases in 2004.

Hospitals reported 284,600 cases, followed by nursing and residential care facilities and ambulatory health care services, with 215,200 and 124,600 cases, respectively.
