


COLAs Online


- A streamlined, expedient, paperless, Internetbased system.
- Allows authenticated Industry Members (IM) to electronically submit Certificate of Label Approval (COLA) applications to the Advertising, Labeling and Formulation Division (ALFD).
- Allows ALFD to electronically review and return a label application to an IM whether it is approved, needs correction, or rejected.



COLAs Online Advantages

- Less time to obtain a COLA approval:
 E-applications are processed in half the time of paper applications.
- E-mail confirmation upon submission of application.
- Fewer rejections received for omissions of data, as the system will not allow you to submit incomplete applications.
- Ability to track the status of your e-applications throughout the entire process.

COLAs Online Advantages (Cont'd)

- No outright rejections: Using e-apps gives you the opportunity to make corrections within 15 calendar days after receiving the correction notice.
- Corrected e-applications that have been resubmitted will receive priority.
- The same qualifications that you receive on paper applications are being used for an even faster turnaround time for e-apps.
- 23/7 access to the system. (Daily routine maintenance is from 4 a.m. to 5 a.m. EST)

Getting Started in COLAs Online



COLAs Online Role Options

- Two Role Options
 - Submitter w/ signing authority allows the user to employ all options that are available, i.e., submitting, correcting, and maintaining a data base of all e-apps sent in for approval.
 - Preparer/ Reviewer role allows user to ONLY prepare the e-app for the Submitter w/ signing authority to send off to TTB for review.

Status Fields

- Received You have successfully uploaded your application.





Status Fields (Cont'd)

- Needs Correction You have corrections that need to be made before you will receive approval.
- Approved Yippee! You did it. You now have an approved COLA and can print off the printable version.
- Rejected Oops. You either waited too long to make changes to the corrections (>15 days) or, in some cases, you have ignored the recommended corrections one too many times and we had to reject the label.



- If you open your label after it has been "successfully uploaded" you can prevent the following image problems before submission:
 - Compression
 - Color Bars / Resolution
 - Red X
 - White Space
 - Illegibility





Uploading Images in COLAs Online



Tips for Successful Images

- JPEG or TIFF images only
- Allotted image file size 450 kb (max)
- JPEG resolution medium or low compression rate
- JPEG quality medium or low
- RGB color mode
- 150 dpi (between 100 200)
- · Only upload image

Tip #1: File Type

- JPEG and TIFF are the only acceptable file formats for label images
- · File extensions will be .jpg or .tif
- JPEG files work best with our system
- PDF and document files may ONLY be used for attachments along with JPEG and TIFF files

Tip #2: Image File Size

 The maximum size for each file uploaded as a label or attachment is 450KB.

Note: The system will not allow you to upload an image larger than 450KB.


Tips #3 and 4: Compression

- One or more of your label images is sized too small for the proper evaluation of your label(s), so that when the dimensions you specify are applied to the label it renders the label as a blurred image. Please remove the current distorted image(s) and replace with new, larger image(s).
- We advise that when you develop your label images, the compression ratio should be set at MEDIUM or LOW so that the file is as close to but still within the file size limit of 450KB.




Tip #5: Color Mode

- Occurs when the wrong color mode is used on image files.
- Check the color mode/space of your label images before uploading. COLAs Online only accepts label images with the type/extensions of JPEG (.jpg) or TIFF (.tif) format utilizing the RGB color mode/space.
- Use the JPEG format! Images in the CMYK color mode/space are unacceptable in COLAs Online.


Tip #6: D.P.I./Resolution

- One or more of your label images bear a "color bar" distortion.
- View this distortion by clicking on your file name in Step 3 of the application.
- Remove the current distorted image(s) and try uploading the file again.
- If this is not successful, we advise that when you or your graphic artist/printer develops your label images in the JPEG or TIFF file format, the resolution rate is set at 150 dots per inch (DPI) or somewhere between the range of 120 DPI and 200 DPI.



Tip #7: Image Upload

- The label file must contain only the label and must be cropped of all surrounding white space or other text.
- The dimensions entered when uploading the labels must take into account the entire file, including both the label image and any white space or other text. All outside measurements that are not a part of the actual label must be removed before upload.
- All printer's proof surrounding details must also be removed.
- You must use the exact measurements of the printed label on the container.

Put your cursor to the right of the image, but not on the image, and then right click your mouse. Then, click on "Select All" and this will highlight the image, including any white space around the image.

Tip #8: Dimensions


- Label dimensions entered are either reversed or incorrect.
- Check the dimensions entered for each label image and ensure the dimensions are correct.
- Keep in mind that the dimensions requested when uploading a label image pertain to the entire file.

Note: Please bear in mind that the dimensions cited must be exact measurements of the printed label that will appear on the container.

Labels Uploaded As One

- Multiple label images appear in one upload.
- Each label must be uploaded separately and identified as "Brand," "Back," "Strip," "Neck," or "Other."
- A separate application must be submitted for each product.

Note: System will now not allow you to submit an application without designating a brand label.

Resubmitting Corrected Image Files

- If your application is returned for correction, make the necessary corrections to your image file. Then open the application and go to Step 3.
 - Remove the original image
 - Find and upload the new image
 - Choose the type of label you are uploading
 - Enter the dimensions of the label
 - · Click on "Attach File"

Frequent Application Errors

- Step 2 of the application is missing information or has the wrong information entered:
 - Terms placed in incorrect fields i.e., Appellation in brand name field, alcohol content in vintage date field. You name it, we have seen it!!
 - Brand name on e-app does not match the label -You must ensure that what is on the brand label appears in this field in its entirety.
 - Alcohol content or other fields do not match what is stated on the label.

Frequent Application Errors (Cont'd)

- Step 2 of the application is missing information or has the wrong information entered:
 - Appellation is missing, incorrect, or differs from what is on the label - i.e., If you have a vintage date, grape varietal, or the label states "Estate Bottled," you MUST have an appellation.
 - Trade name/ DBA does not match the label This
 information must be added to the application each time
 it is used on the label. Furthermore, the DBA is added
 when the bottler's or importer's company name is
 different from the operating name that is listed on your
 permit. **DBA must be registered with the National
 Revenue Center before use.

- You give us your registration form because you are SO excited about this system!!
- We <u>expedite</u> your application because you have taken this class!!
- It will take at least 2 weeks to process. Normal processing time is 30 days.
- Look for an e-mail from TTB. Watch your junk mail filter—customers have told us that our e-mail filtered into their junk inbox.
- If you have an e-mail filter, save alfd@ttb.gov as an accepted e-mail address.

- The Public COLA Registry is available to public users (e.g., the States and Customs)
- Provides limited access to search for and view approved, surrendered, expired, and revoked COLAs.
- · The searcher may:
 - Search for COLAs
 - View limited COLA details
 - Display and print completed COLAs
 - View Frequently Asked Questions
- Approved COLAs uploaded within 48 hour
- · NO USER ID or PASSWORD is NEEDED!
