### Family Advocacy Specialist (FAS)

The FAS helps members prevent and resolve family violence. This includes consulting with commands, providing referrals, and overseeing treatment process to completion. Areas of focus include: physical/emotional partner abuse, child abuse/neglect, elder abuse and parent abuse. Training and subject matter expertise is offered in all areas related to family relationships.

The FAS hosts the annual required training on family advocacy issues for command leadership and is available for All Hands training at the command's request.

### **Health Promotion Manager (HPM)**

The HPM educates, supports, and encourages Coast Guard members and their families in all areas related to health and well-being, with emphasis on

- Physical Fitness
- Nutrition and Weight Control
- Stress Management
- Tobacco Cessation
- Cardio Vascular Health
- Substance Abuse Prevention

The HPM provides comprehensive Health Risk Appraisals for individuals and commands, and hosts annual Health Promotions Coordinator Training.
