SUBJECT: PATERNITY OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM (POP) VIDEO CONFERENCE
WORKSHOP- OCTOBER 28, 2004

The California Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) will present a video conference workshop for all local child support agency (LCSA) POP Coordinators on Thursday, October 28, 2004, from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. The video conference workshop will focus on the new POP regulations.

DCSS POP staff will provide a comprehensive presentation on such topics as the new photo identification and social security number requirements, the more stringent review process for filing valid paternity declarations and the introduction of the revised Declaration of Paternity form. The workshop will be critical for LCSA staff who work with local hospitals in providing the voluntary paternity process. Attached is a draft agenda for the video conference.

LCSA POP Coordinators will be contacted directly by DCSS POP staff regarding sites for the video conference. DCSS POP staff will also conduct on-site training for specified hospitals in October and November 2004. LCSA POP Coordinators will be expected to provide training to hospitals in their county that do not receive the on-site training. Attached is a listing of the LCSAs where DCSS POP staff are planning on conducting on-site hospital training.

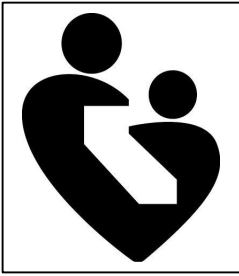
