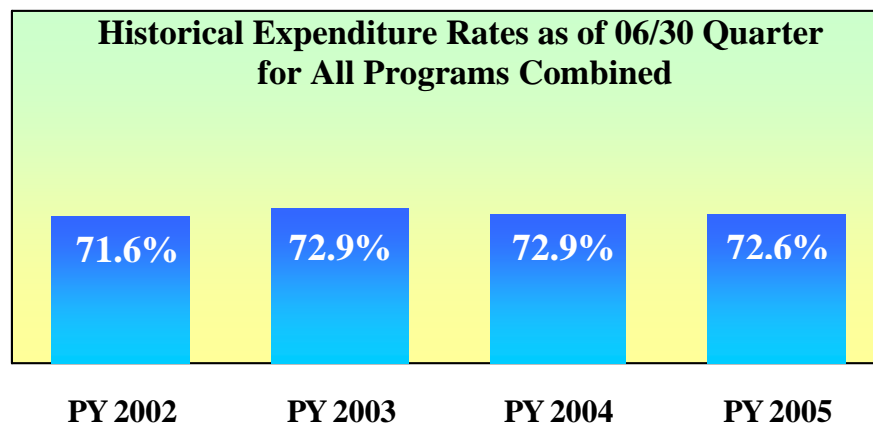

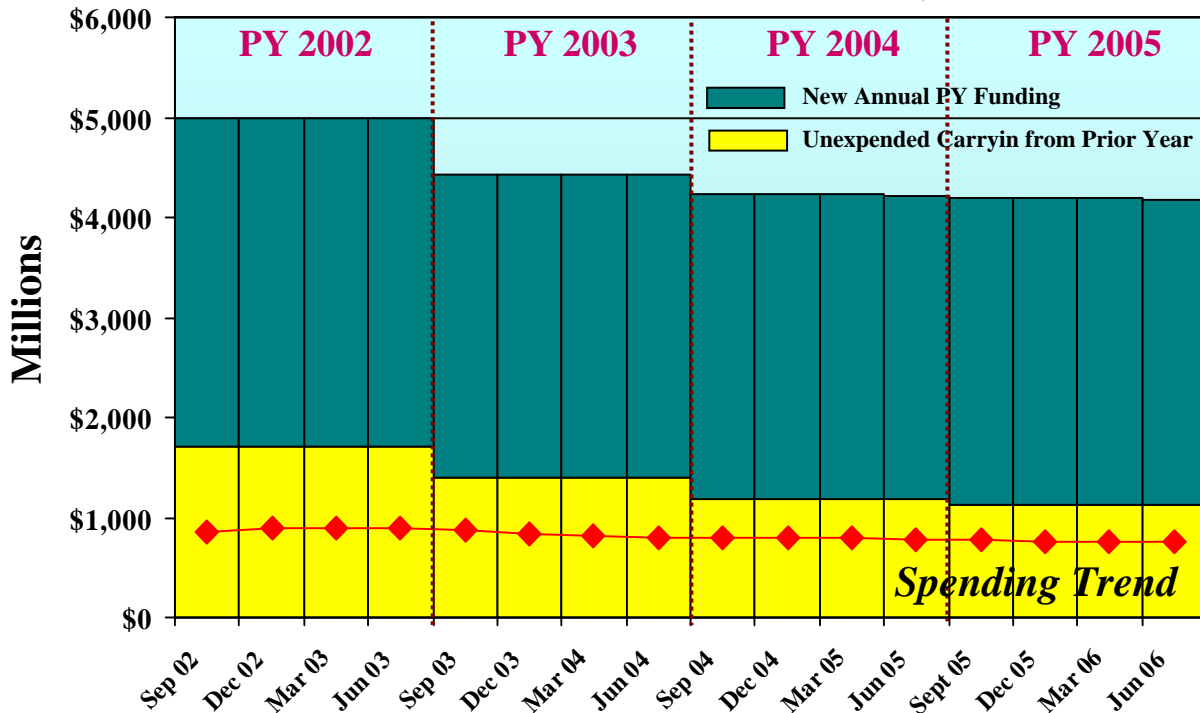
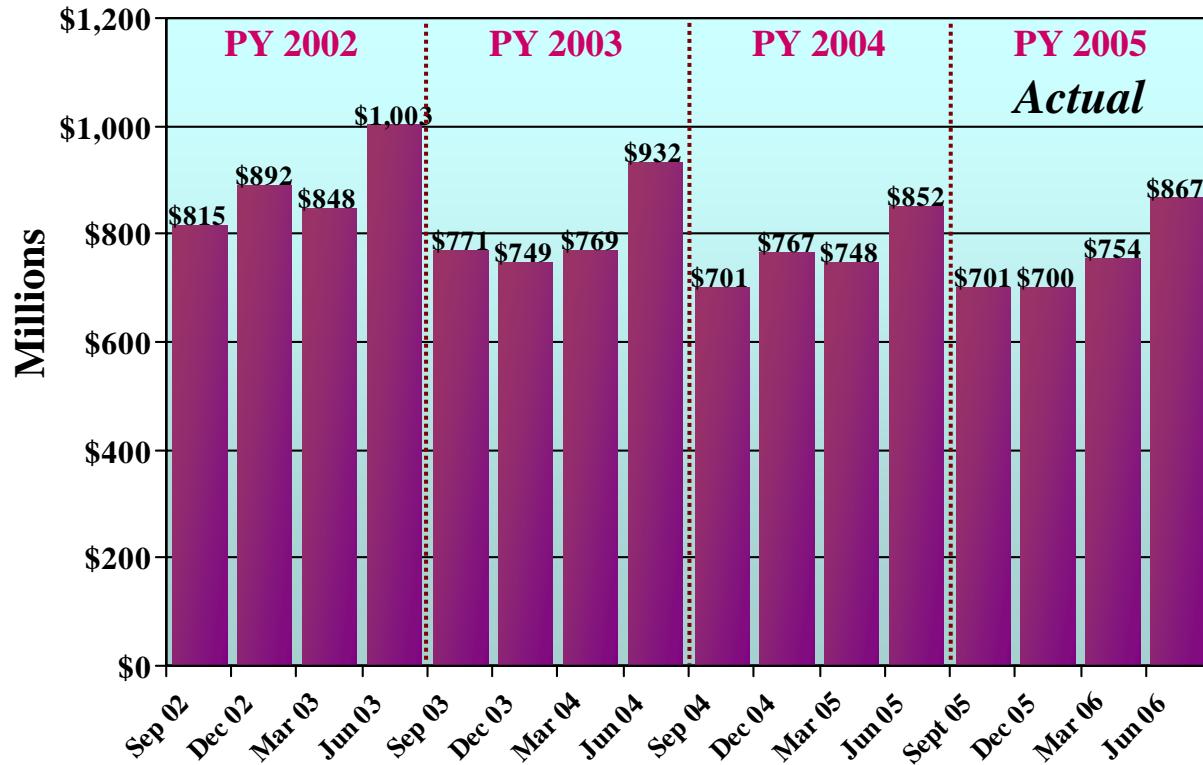
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## WIA Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker Formula Programs State Spending for PY 2005, as of the Quarter Ending 06/30/06 Highlights

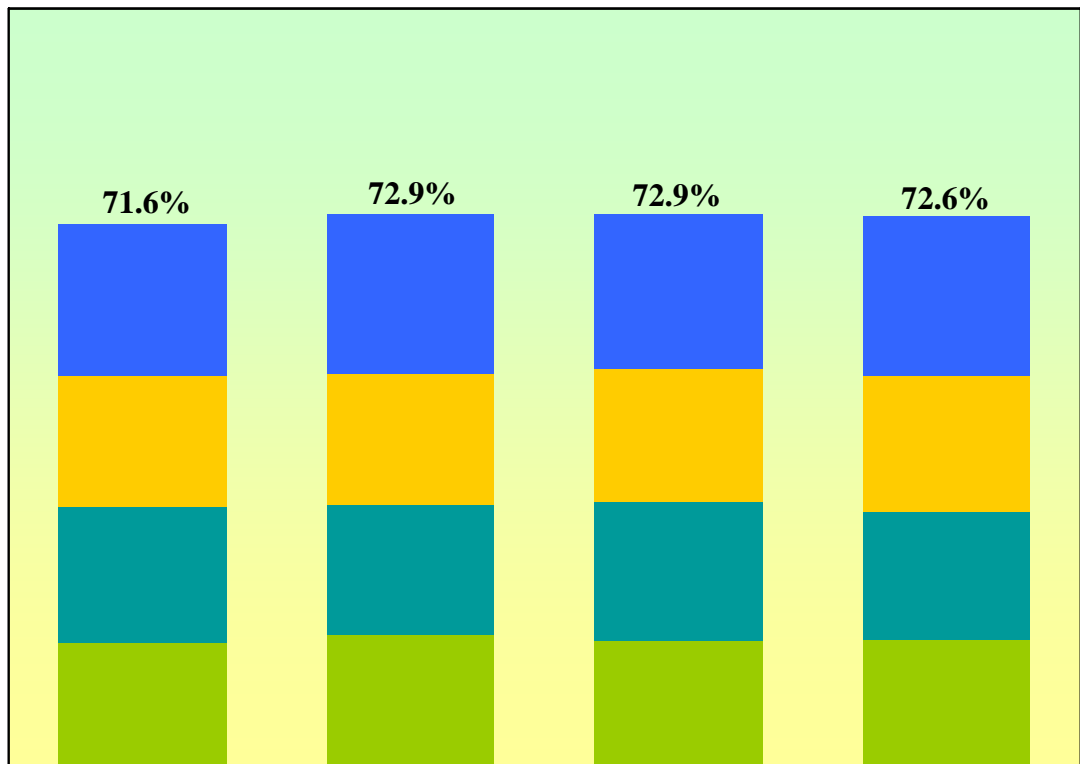


- Total available funding for States for all programs for PY 2005, including carry-in from prior years, is down \$43 million (-1.0%) from the funding level available for PY 2004. This decrease is due to a drop in carry-in (-\$44 million, -3.8%) offset partially by an increase in new funding (\$2 million, 0.1%). Carry-in represents 27% of total funds available for PY 2005, as compared to 28% of funds in PY 2004. Carry-in levels have gradually declined each year since PY 2001; however, the PY 2005 carry-out level remains virtually the same as the PY 2005 carry-in level.
- As of 06/30/06, States were spending 72.6% of available funds in all three programs for PY 2005, essentially the same rate as in PY 2004 (72.9%).
- Total spending as of the fourth quarter (including the prior April-June quarter for the Youth program) was \$3.028 billion, down \$42 million, or -1.4%, compared to last year, and down \$193 million or -6.0% from PY 2003. This appears to be largely due to the decrease in total funds available to spend.
- The PY 2005 expenditure rates for the Dislocated Workers and Youth programs showed a slight decrease from PY 2004 while the Adult program showed a slight increase. The Dislocated Workers program continued to spend a lower proportion of available funds than the other programs.
- Spending rates for PY 2005 at state and local activity levels were, respectively, 54.4% and 79.8%, essentially unchanged when compared to 54.2% and 79.9% for PY 2004. Since PY 2000, State spending rates have continued to lag behind local spending rates, and local administration activity spending rates, while higher than state activity level spending, have been lower than local program rates.
- For PY 2005, 21 states showed increases in expenditure rates in all programs combined compared to PY 2004 rates.
- At the end of PY 2005, the number of states with expenditure rates below 70% is 11 for Adults, 6 for Youth, and 27 for Dislocated Workers. The total unexpended balances above 30% of total available funding for these states are as follows: Adults, \$14.3 million; Youth, \$7.3 million; Dislocated Workers, \$99.1 million.

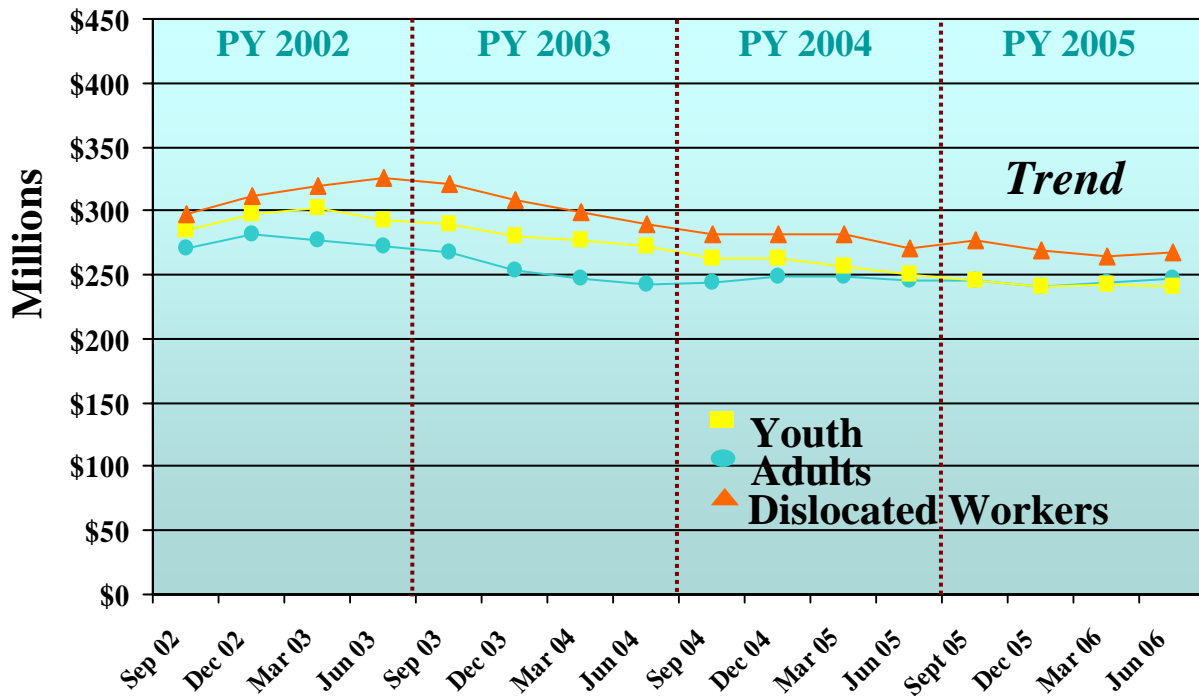
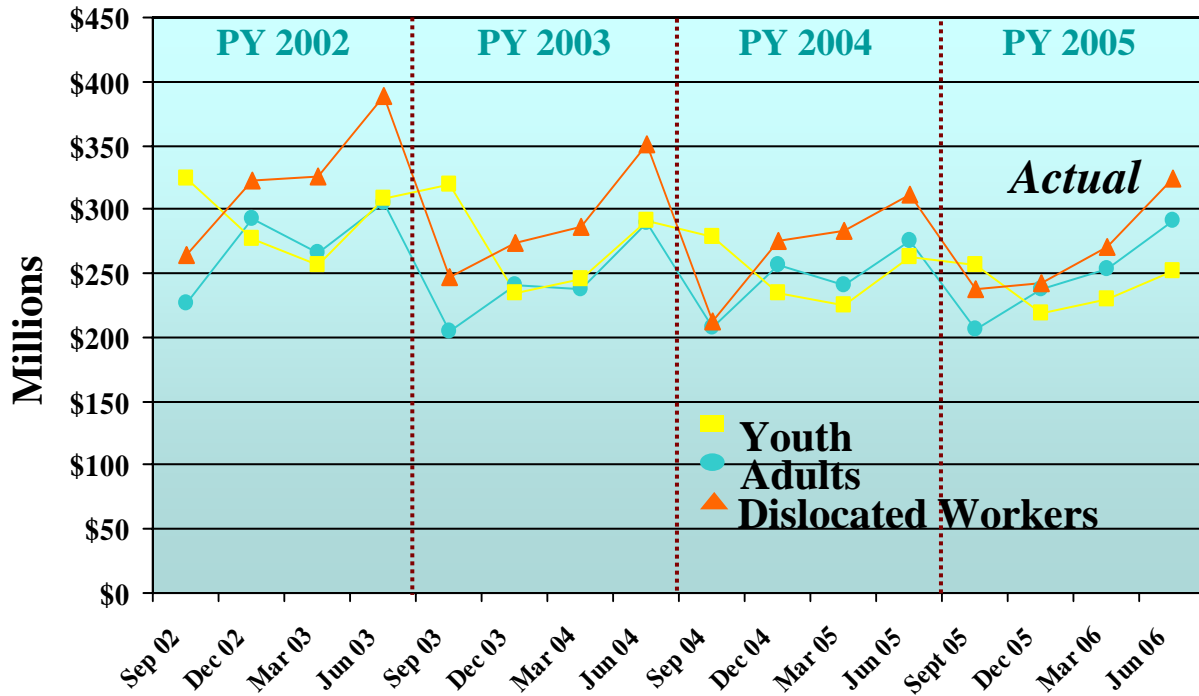


## WIA Youth/Adults/Dislocated Worker Formula Programs, Combined Expenditure Rates for PY 2002 - 2005

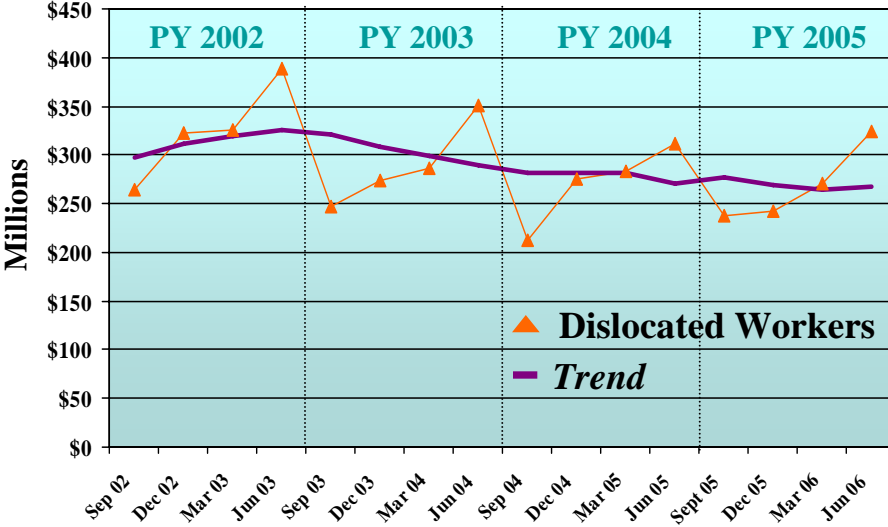
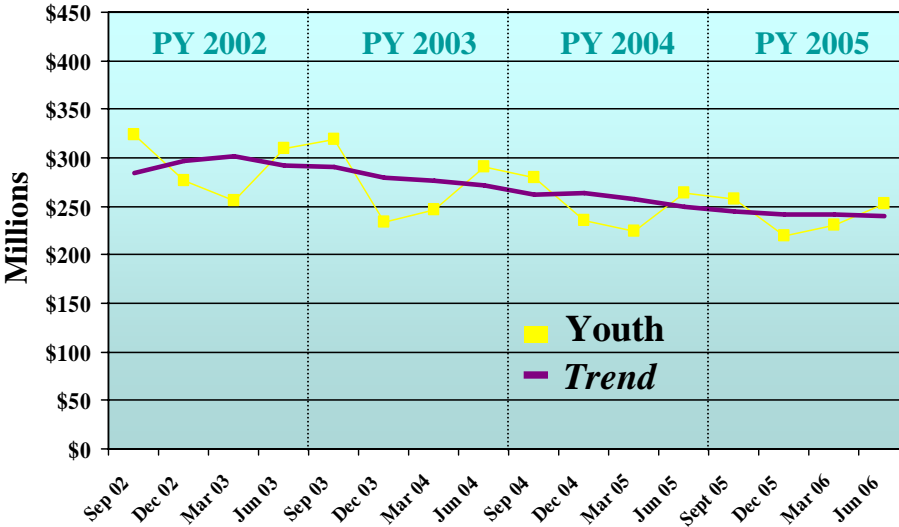
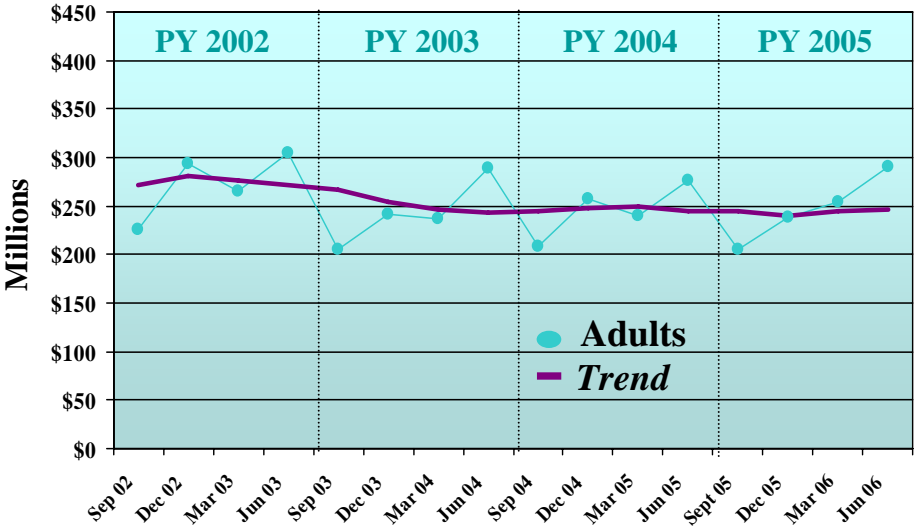

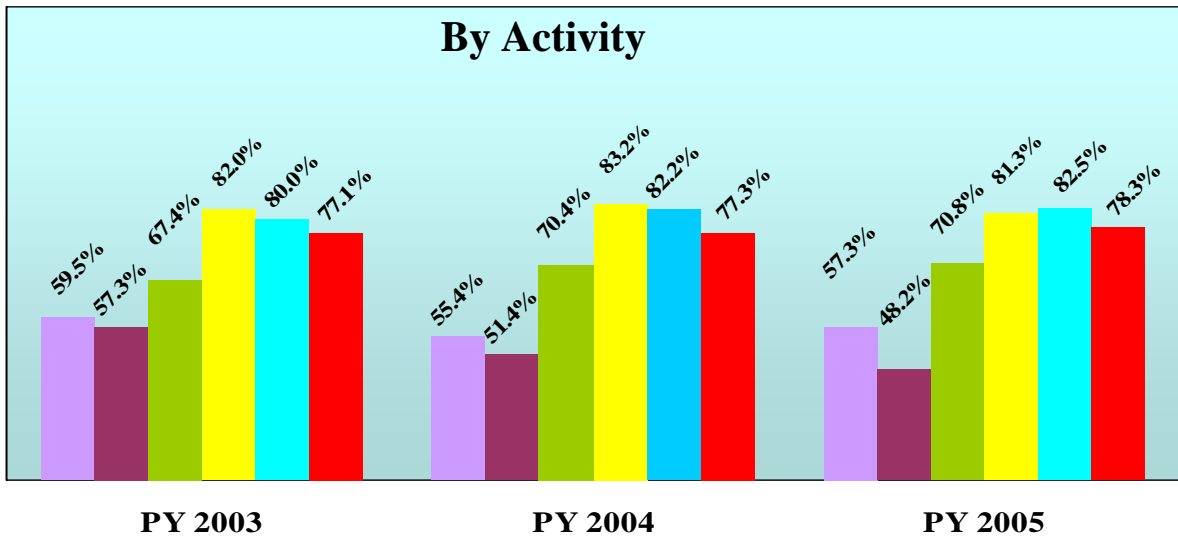
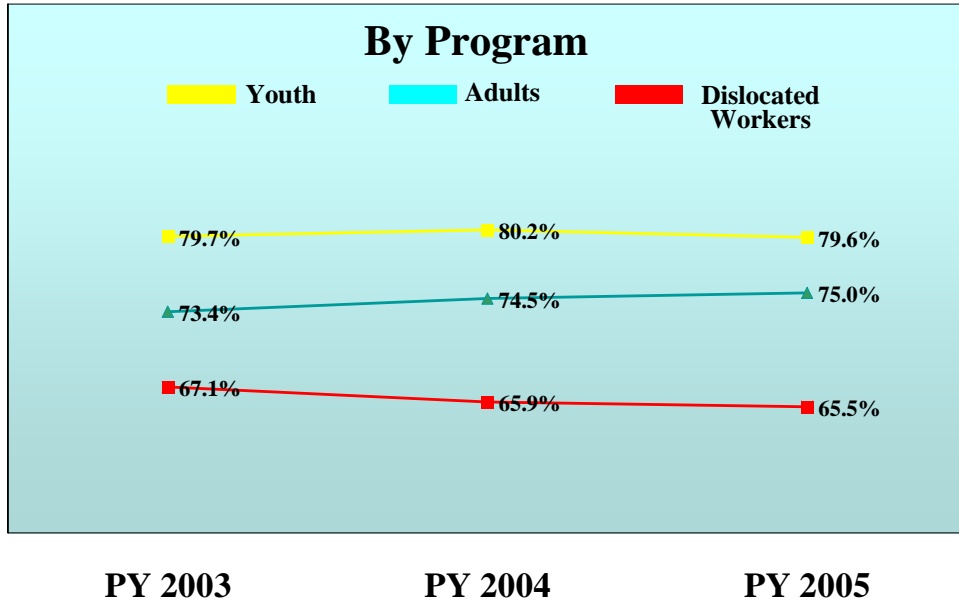
# WIA Youth/Adult/Dislocated Worker Formula Programs Net Quarterly State Spending , PY 2002-PY 2005 As of 06/30/06

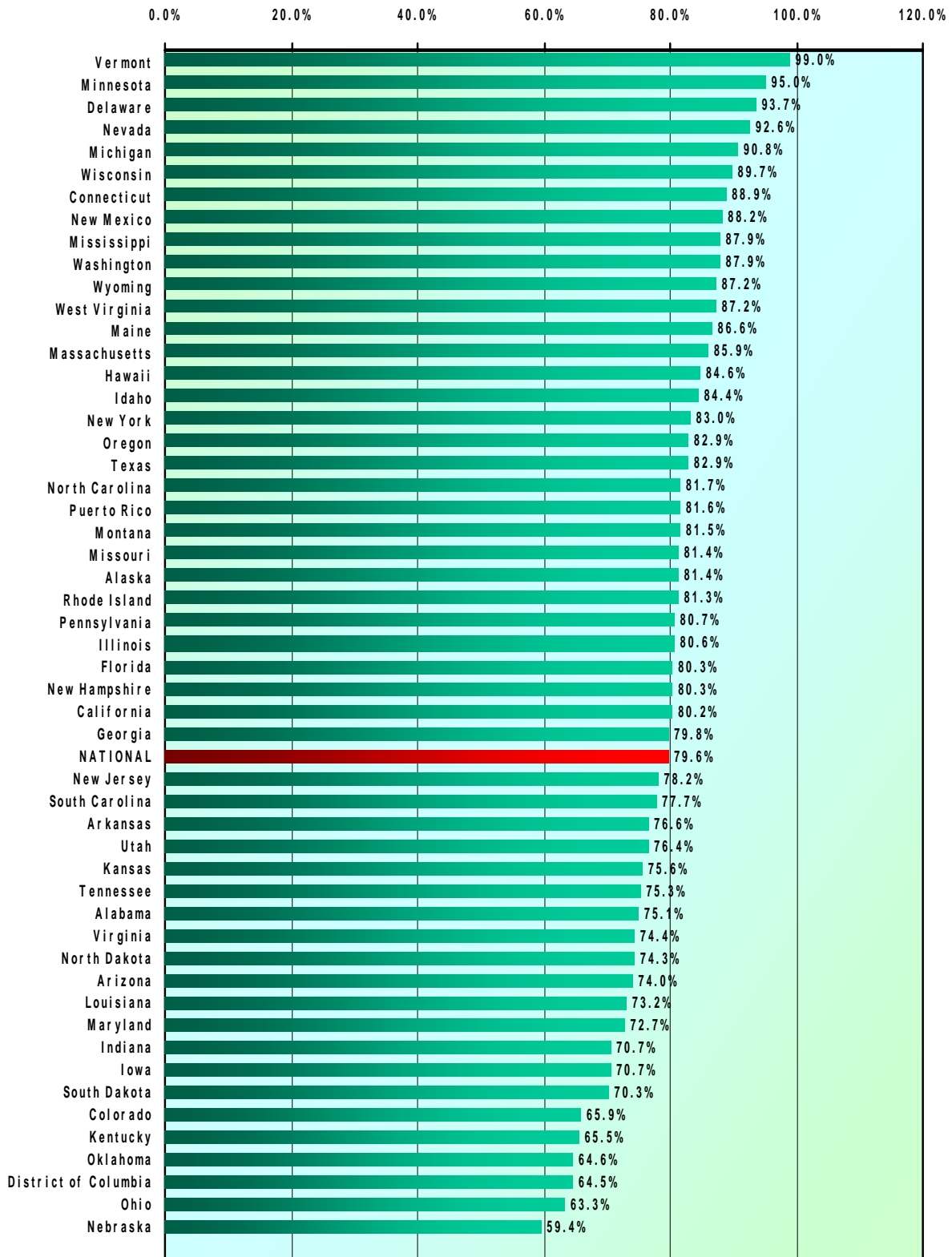

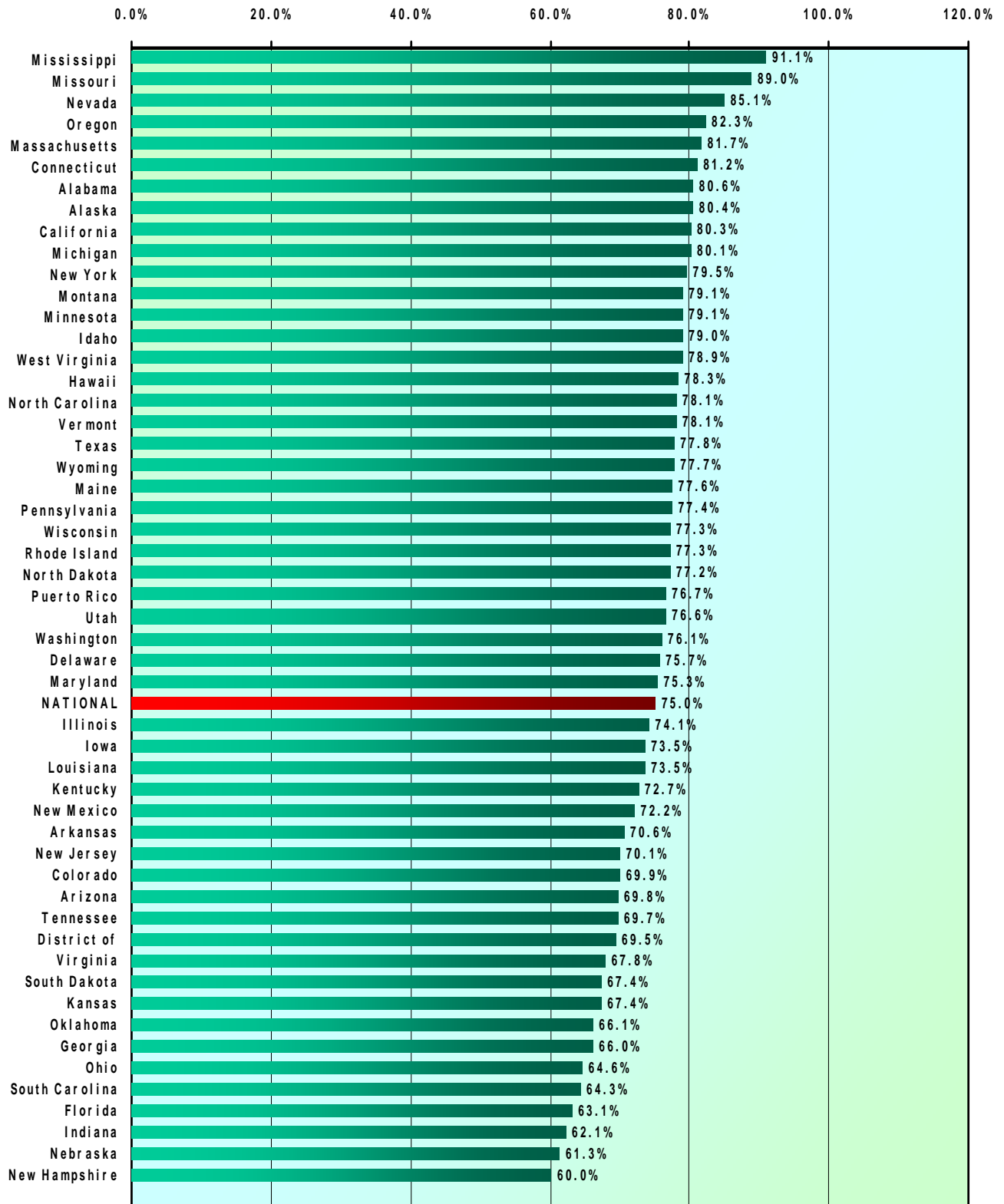
## State PY 2005 Expenditure Rates for Quarter Ending 06/30/06





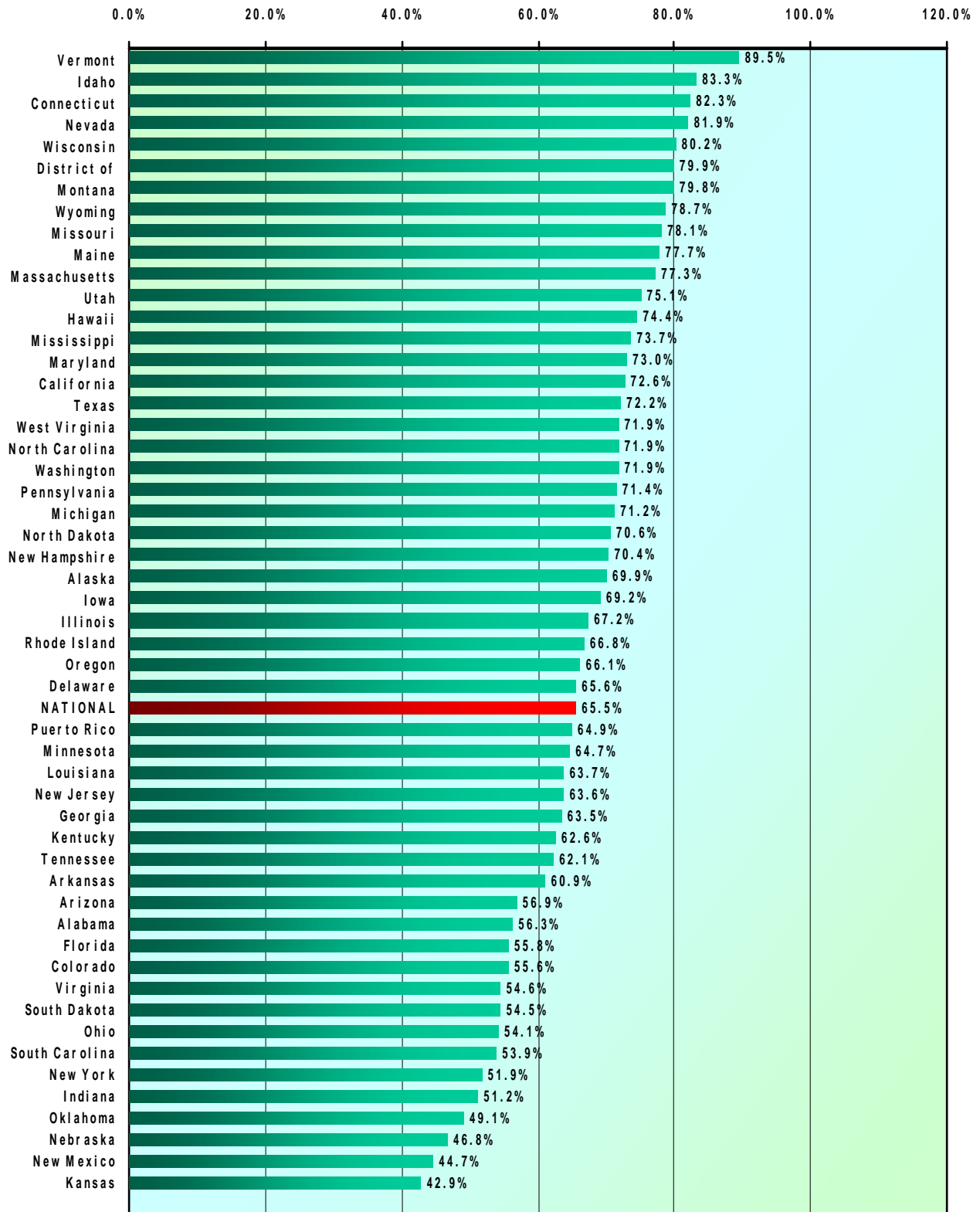

## State PY 2005 Expenditure Rates for Quarter Ending 06/30/06

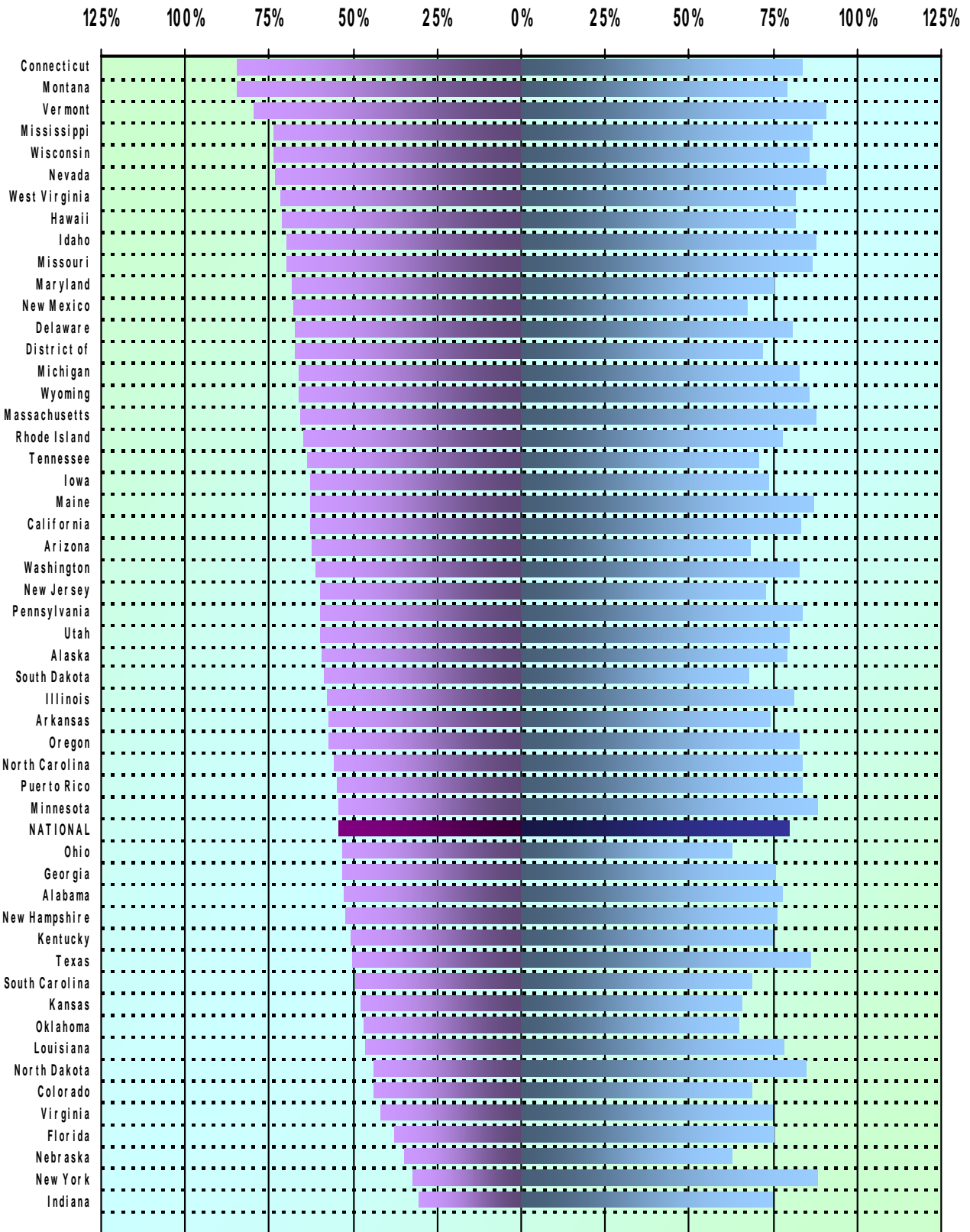
