¹All outcomes exclude individuals who were institutionalized, deceased, or had health/medical that precluded continuation of services or entry into employment at exit.

² Skill attainment rate is based on only on exiters and not on continuing participants. It includes goals attained or expired without attainment before April 2006. This differs from the official goal attainment rate, which includes continuing participants and counts any goals attained for expired without attainment between April 2005 and March 2006.
