IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF GUAM FOR HORSES AND OTHER EQUIDAE FROM THE UNITED STATES

The animals must be accompanied by a U.S. Origin Health Certificate issued by a veterinarian authorized by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and endorsed by a Veterinary Services (VS) veterinarian. The certificate shall contain the name and address of both the consignor and consignee and complete identification of the animals to be exported. Additional information shall include:

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS

- 1. The animals are free from external parasites and symptoms of transmissible diseases or evidence of recent exposure to such diseases.
- 2. The animals originated from an area in which equine encephalomyelitis has not occurred within the 6 months preceding export.
- 3. The animals were vaccinated for Eastern and Western equine encephalomyelitis with a USDA-approved vaccine on _____ (date), with _____ (name of the vaccine).
- 4. The animals have been completely sponged or sprayed, thoroughly wetting mane and tail, with a one-half of one percent water solution of malathion wettable powder or other USDA-approved pesticide on ______ (date) within 7 days from export.

TEST REQUIREMENTS

The animals were tested negative to the following disease within 90 days of export (Results, date of test, and name of laboratory shall be stated on the health certificate):

Equine Infectious Anemia: Coggins test

EMBARKATION CERTIFICATION

At the port of embarkation, a VS port veterinarian shall attach to the U.S. Origin Health Certificate, the Certificate of Inspection of Export Animals (VS Form 17-37) showing:

- 1. The name and address of the consignor.
- 2. The name and address of the consignee.
- 3. The number and species of animals to be shipped.
- 4. A statement that the animals have been given a careful veterinary inspection at the port of embarkation and found free from evidence of communicable disease and exposure thereto within 24 hours of exportation.
