IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF PERU FOR DOGS AND CATS EXPORTED FROM THE UNITED STATES

The animals must be accompanied by a health certificate issued, dated and signed by a licensed, USDA-accredited veterinarian. The certificate must contain the name and address of the owner, and complete identification of the animal (name, breed, sex and age). In addition, the certificate must show:

- 1. The animal(s) (3 months or older) were vaccinated against rabies.
- 2. In the case of dogs, that they were vaccinated (according to age) against parvovirus, hepatitis, distemper and leptospirosis.
- 3. In the case of cats, a sworn declaration signed by the importer. Cats need to be vaccinated for: Calicivirus, Rhinotracheitis, and Infectious Panleucopenia.

Other information:

- 1. The veterinarian's license number must appear on the health certificate.
- 2. The health certificate must be endorsed by the USDA.
