**Description of Entry:** In an effort to make end-users more aware of the growing menace of HTML-based viruses, we created the attached poster. It is designed to look like some sort of public warning sign that one might find affixed to a post at a beachfront area. The rectangular sign is done in a typical yellow background with black lettering. The caption at the top is in red, to stand out better and to differentiate the caption wording from the message on the sign. We hope that the pictorial message of the "huge wave" causing the surfer to "wipe out" may cause employees to think twice about carelessly surfing the web.
