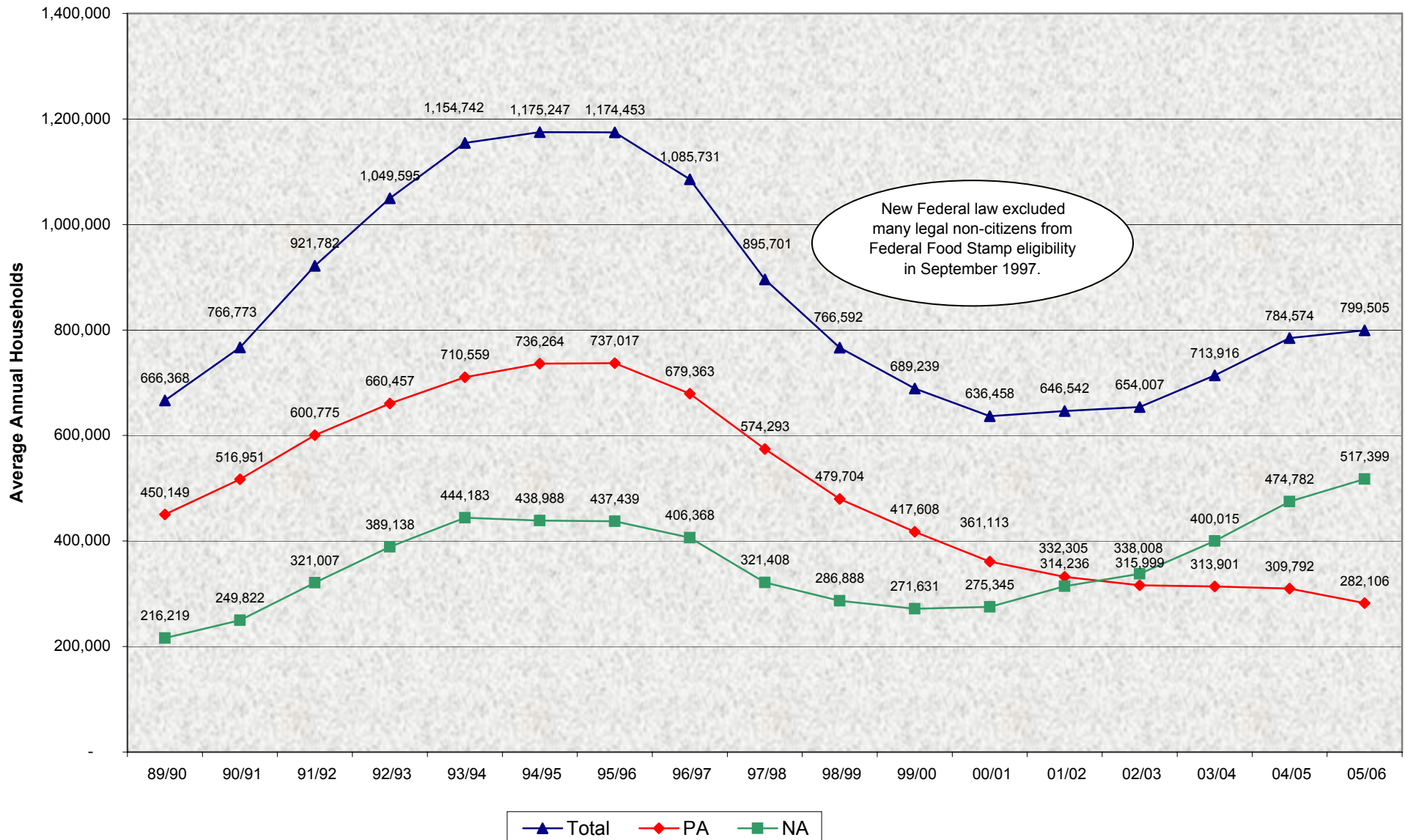


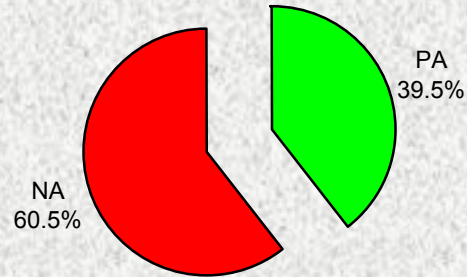

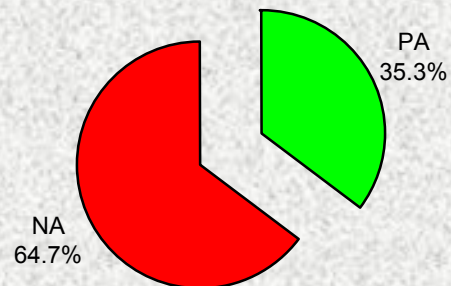

TRENDS

NOTE: The number of Federal households is the total Federal-Only households plus the Federal share of combined households (households which include federally eligible and California Food Assistance Program [CFAP] eligible persons). The Federal share of combined households is calculated using a proration based on the number of Federal and CFAP persons in combined households.

- **Food Stamp annual average households increased 1.9% between FY 04/05 and FY 05/06.**
8.9% decrease in PA households
9.0% increase in NA households
- **Food Stamp annual average households hit a high of 1,175,252 in FY 94/95 and then started a downward trend. The largest decrease, 17.5%, occurred between FY 96/97 and FY 97/98 when Federal law changed to exclude many legal non-citizens from Federal Food Stamp eligibility. The downward trend is continuing for Public Assistance households.**
- **Continuing a recent trend, both the number and relative proportion of Nonassistance households continue to increase while the number and proportion of Public Assistance households decreases.**
The number of Nonassistance households now exceeds the number of Public Assistance households by 235,293 households.
The ratio of Public Assistance and Nonassistance households changed from 39.5% Public Assistance and 60.5% Nonassistance in FY 04/05 to 35.3% Public Assistance and 64.7% Nonassistance in FY 05/06.
