Q&As for Federally Recognized Tribes, American Indian and Alaska Natives

- Is a federally recognized tribal government considered in the same manner as a state throughout the selection processes?
 - Yes, each entity, state and federally recognized tribal government, will be considered equally throughout the selection process.
- Can one or more federally recognized tribal governments apply from the same state, even if the state is submitting an application?
 - Yes, each is a separate entity and each application will be reviewed and if selected will advance. The potential pool of applicants includes all 50 states, the U.S. territories, District of Columbia, U.S. Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and all federally recognized tribal governments.
- Can more than one federally recognized tribal government be part of a state team?
 Yes, more than one federally recognized tribal government can work on a state team.
- Can multiple federally recognized tribal governments collaborate to submit a joint application?
 - Yes, however there must be one lead agency that is recognized.
