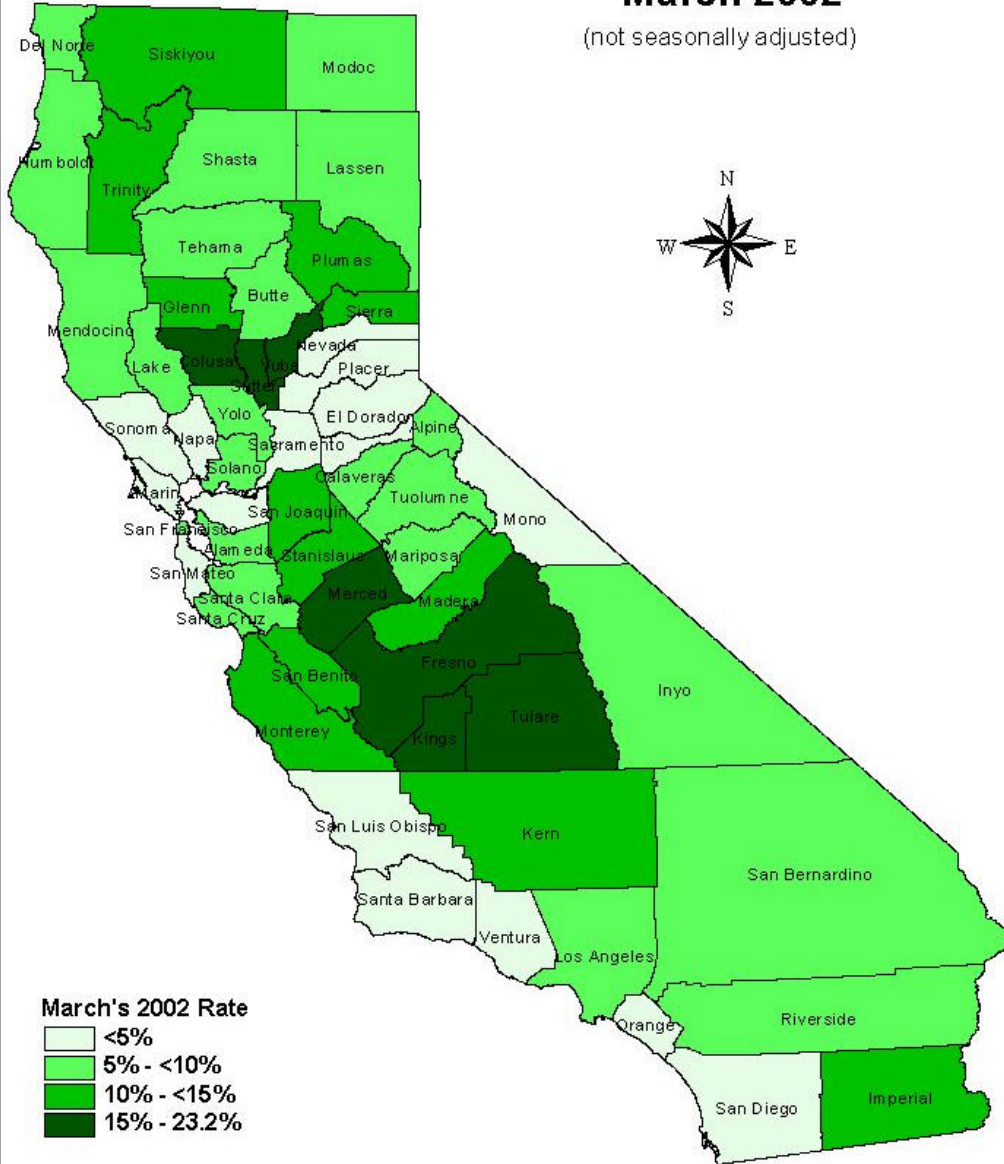


# California's Unemployment Rate March 2002
