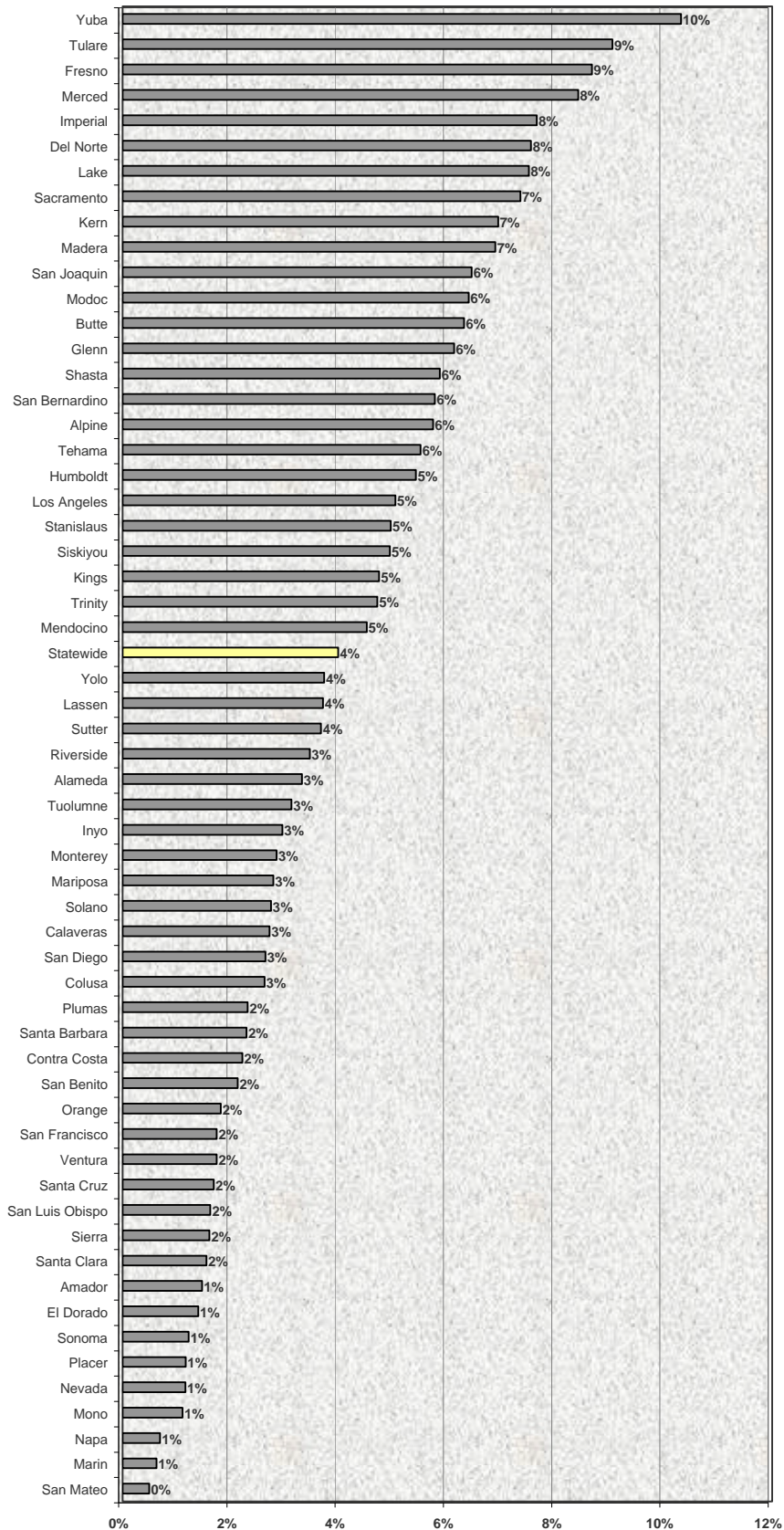


## CalWORKS Program Percent of Population Receiving CalWORKS January 2001
