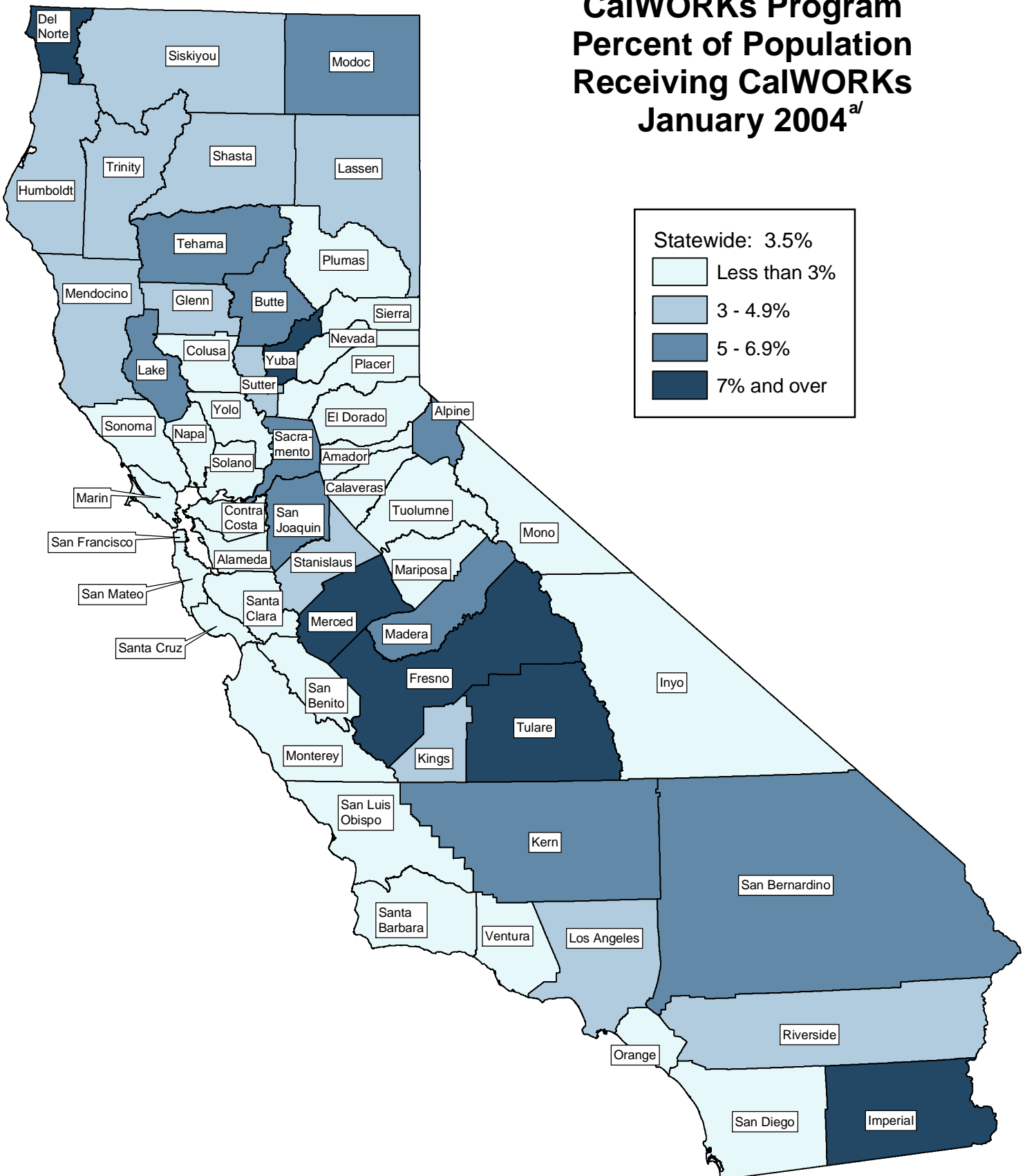
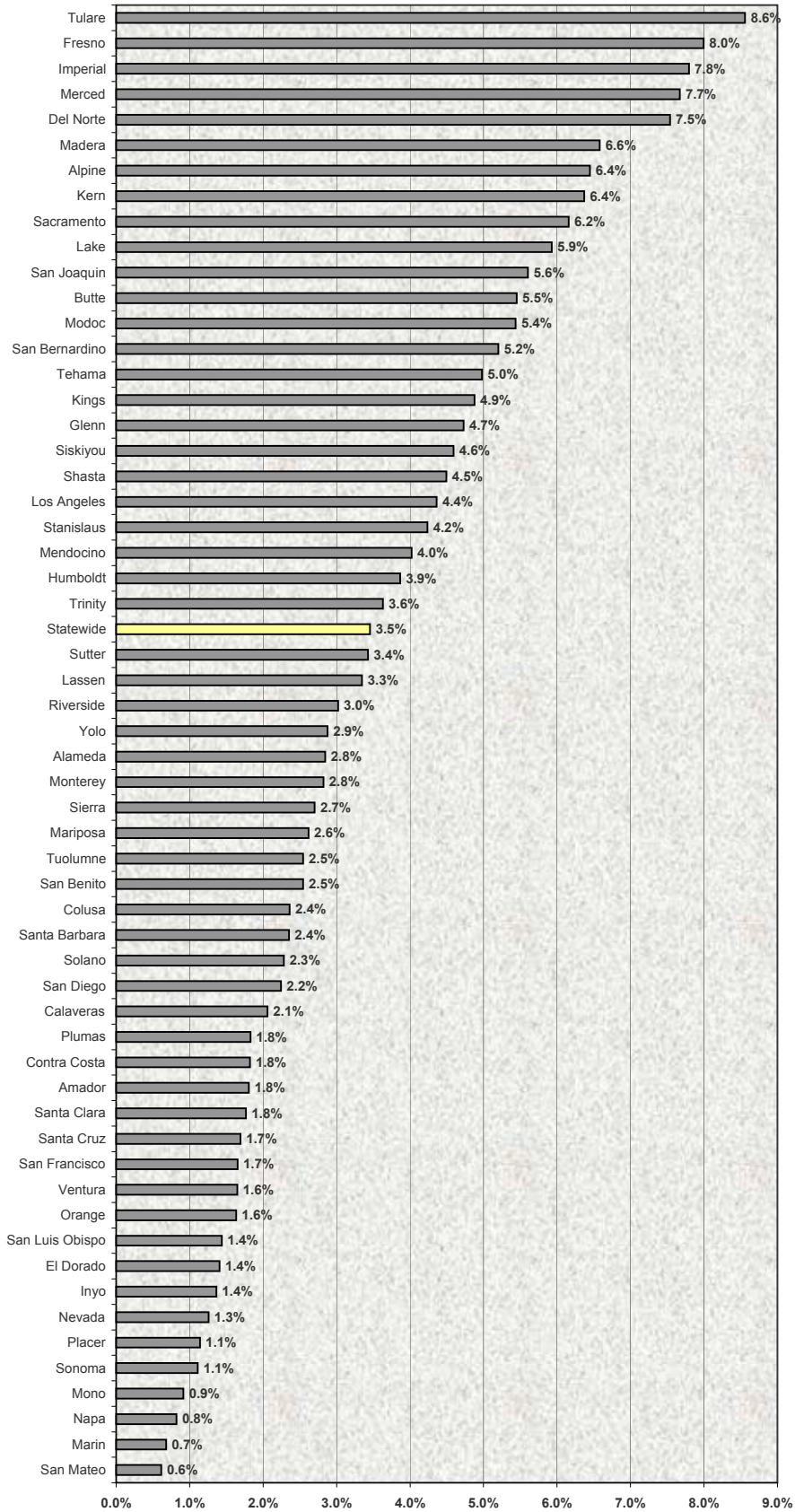


CalWORKs Program Percent of Population Receiving CalWORKs January 2004^{a/}
