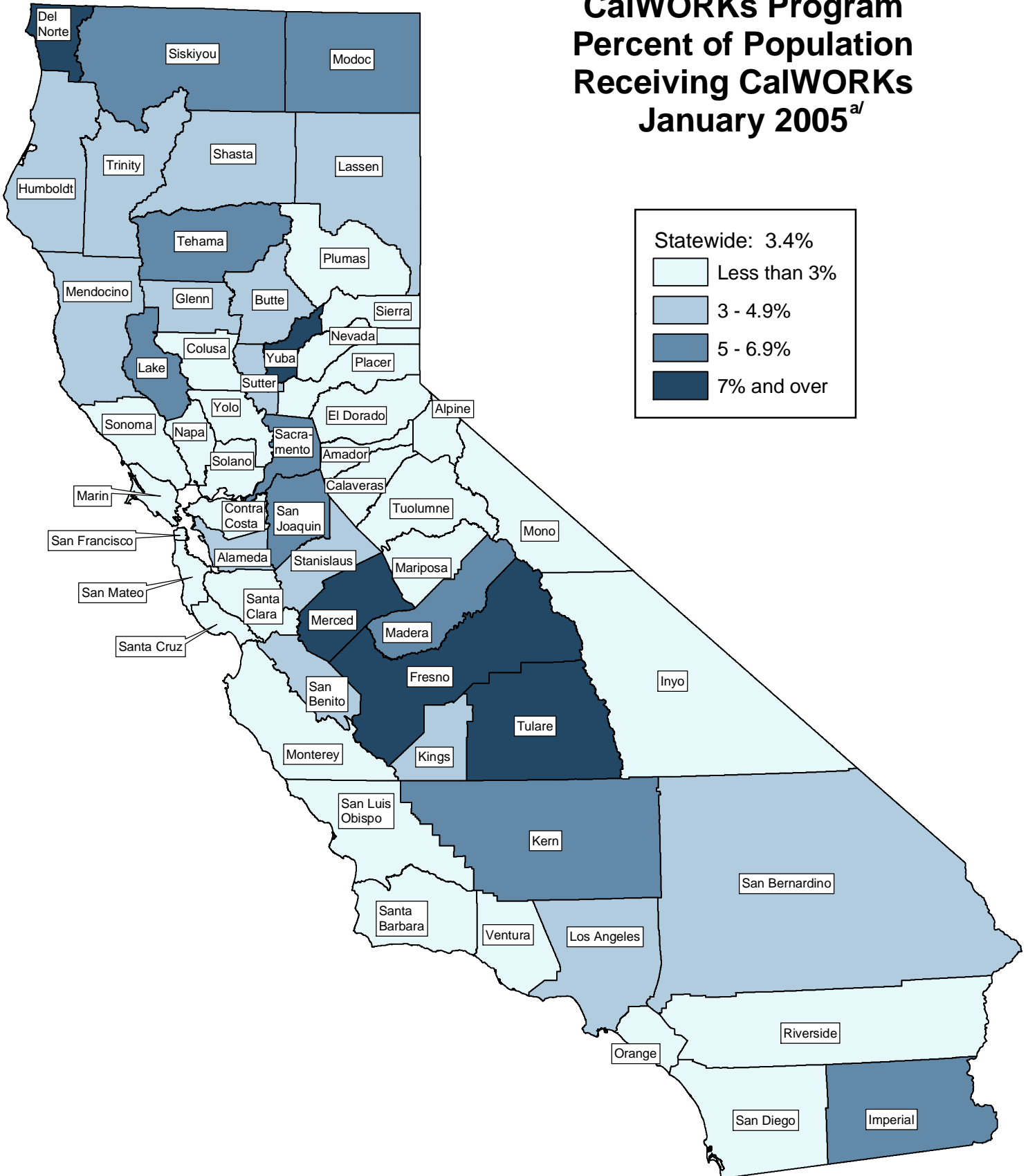
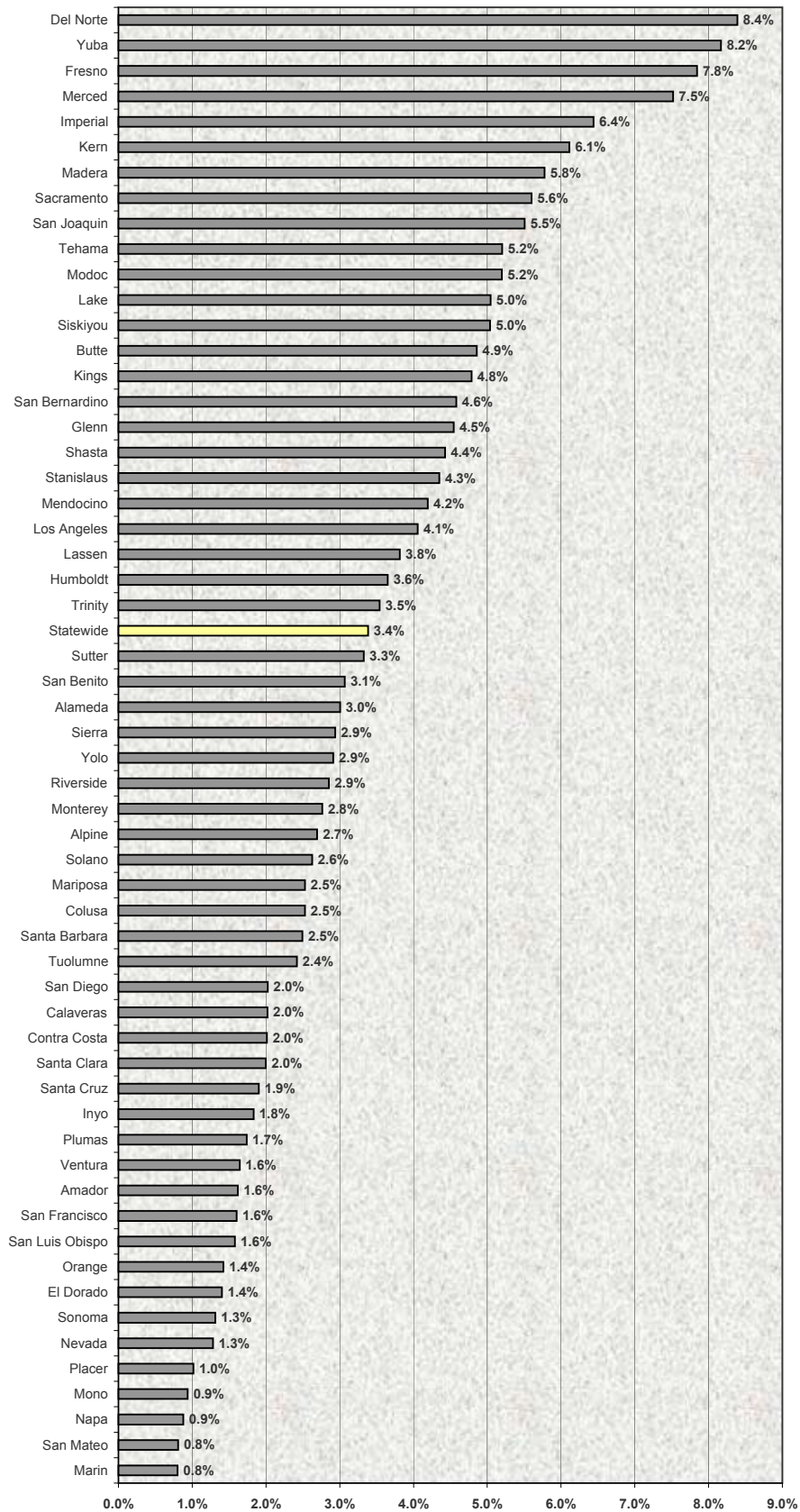


CalWORKs Program Percent of Population Receiving CalWORKs January 2005^{a/}
