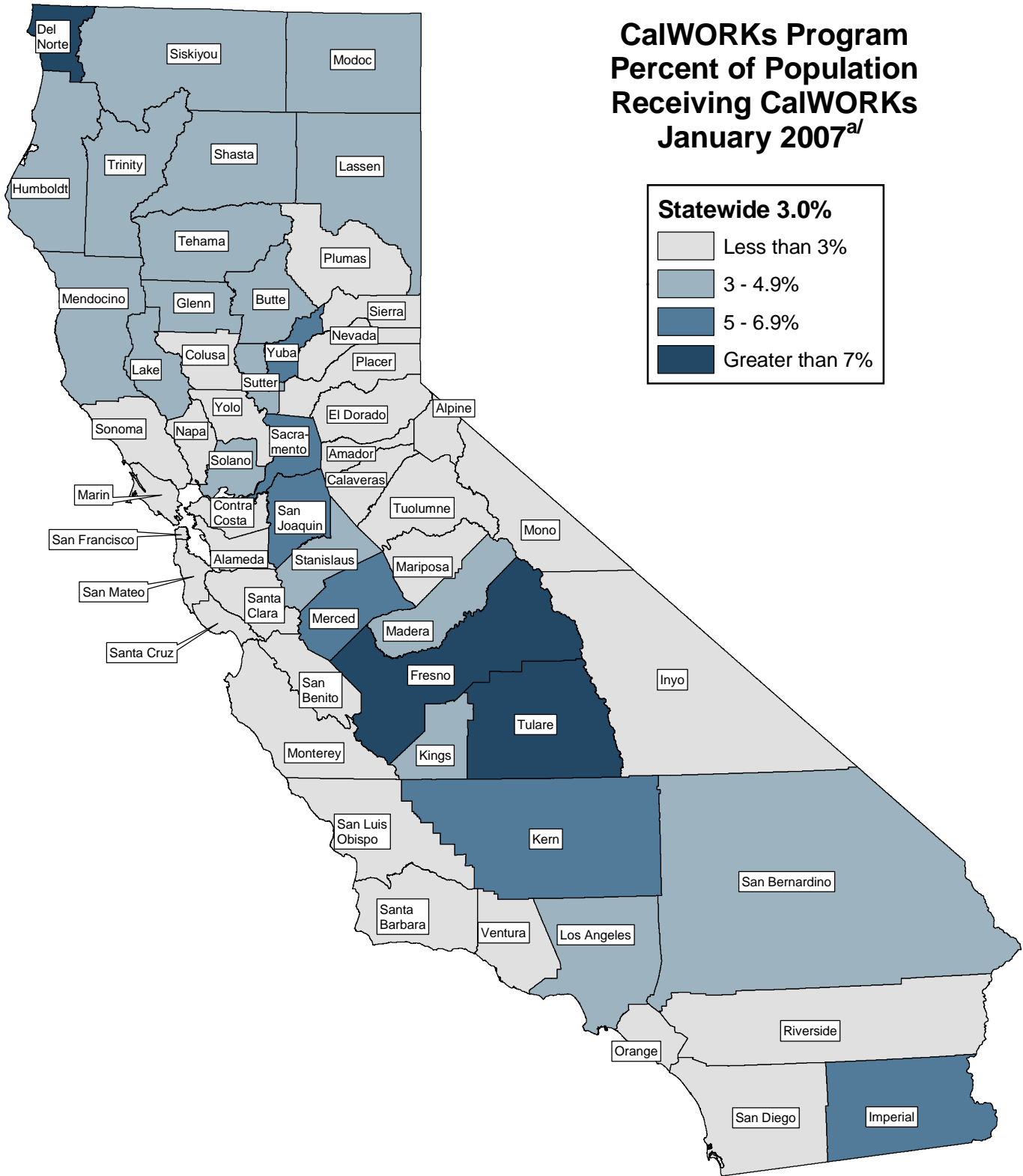
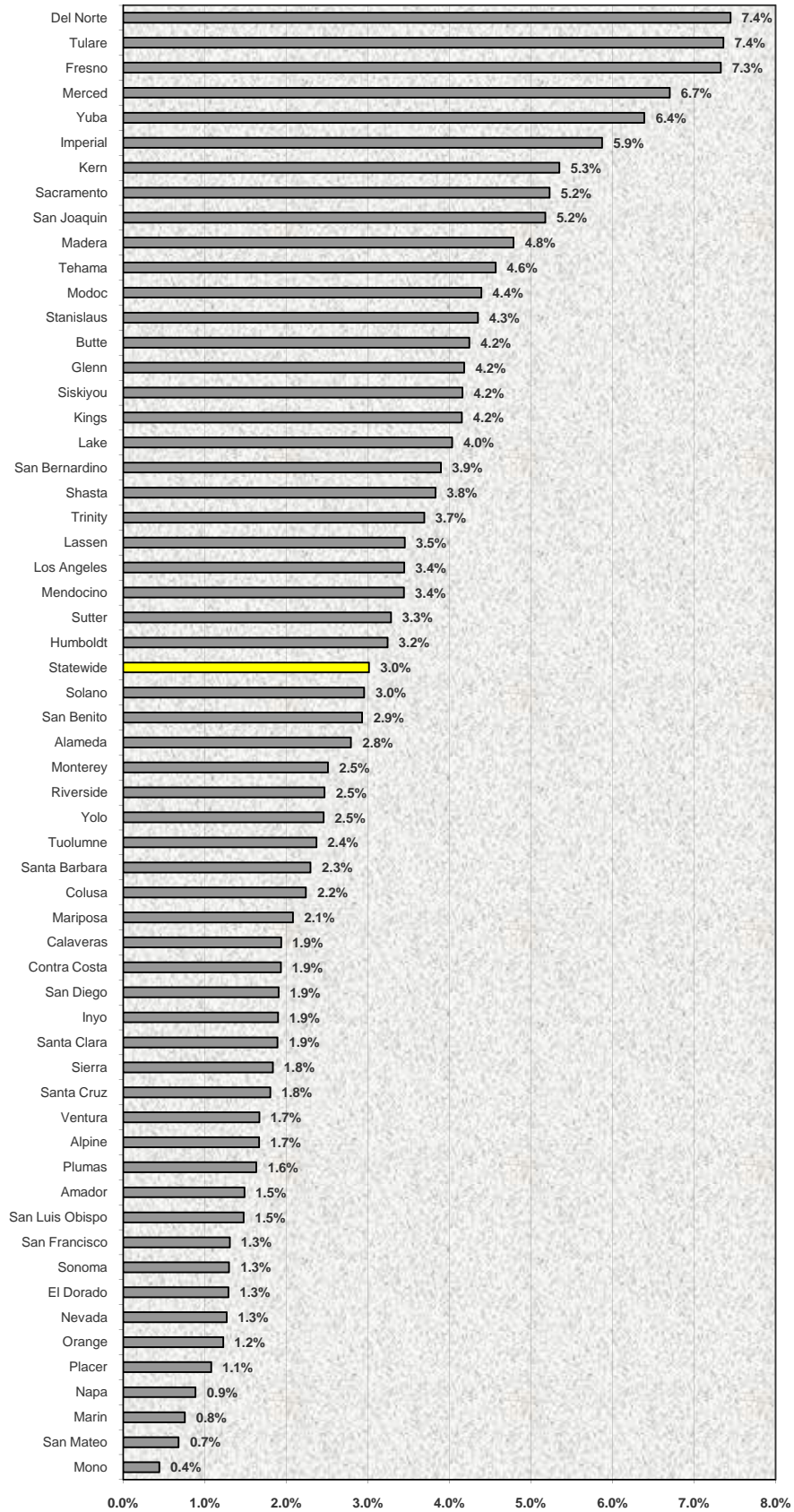


CalWORKs Program Percent of Population Receiving CalWORKs January 2007^{a/}
