

## What Services Are Provided?

There are clinics throughout King County that provide some or all of the following services. Call the clinic closest to you for an appointment or more information about the services they can offer you.

- ⇒ Complete medical care for the whole family
- ⇒ Immunizations
- ⇒ Family Planning and women's health care, including pregnancy testing
- ⇒ Treatment for sexually transmitted diseases (STD)
- ⇒ Dental Care
- ⇒ WIC food and nutrition programs
- ⇒ Interpretation for those who speak limited English
