Tallapoosa County 2 N Alexander City to 4 N Alexander City 0139CST 0142CST 01 2 50 80K 2KTornado (F0) A small tornado touched down on the north side of Alexander City downing trees and power lines in a predominantly residential section. Several structures sustained damage though most of it was fairly minor. Reports indicated that two single-family homes sustained major damage with minor damage to an additional nine homes. **Montgomery County** 7.5 E Montgomery to 01 0142CST 200K 5K Thunderstorm Wind (G70) 10.5 E Montgomery 0150CST What was believed to be strong thunderstorm wind downed trees, power lines, and large billboards in a three mile long path along Interstate 85 east of Montgomery. Damage began on the southside of the Interstate at exit 9 and extended along the Interstate crossing to the northside just before exit 11. A Conoco quick stop mart and gas station was completely destroyed at exit 11. Additional tree damage and minor roof damage extended about a mile to the east-northeast from exit 11 into the Techno Center industrial area. Elmore County Millbrook 01 0143CST 0200CST 10K Flash Flood A car was washed off the road and into a ditch along with tremendous street flooding in the Millbrook area in the southwestern part of the county. **Elmore County** 3.5 S Tallassee 01 0156CST 0 0 40K 0 Thunderstorm Wind (G50) Two mobile homes located along Highway 229 south of Tallassee were completely destroyed by what appeared to be straight-line wind. The mobile homes were about 300 feet apart with a small, brick home situated between them with several trees around it. There was no evidence of damage at the brick home or in the trees surrounding it. No injuried occurred because no one was in either mobile home. Tallapoosa County 3 E Tallassee to 4 E Tallassee 45K 10K 01 Thunderstorm Wind (G50) A hay storage barn was destroyed, and several buildings sustained minor damage when thunderstorm wind struck an area on the north side of Highway 14 about 3.5 miles east of Tallassee in extreme southern Tallapoosa County. EMA officials reported nine single-family dwellings sustained minor damage with one sustaining major damage. Reports also indicated that three mobile homes
