Thomaston is in eastern Marengo County. **Dallas County** Orrville 0900CST 15K 2KThunderstorm Wind (G55) Three trailers were destroyed and one trailer was damaged along with downed trees. A concrete block building suffered major damage. Orrville is in the western part of the county. **Bibb County** 5 WSW West Blocton 0910CST 0911CST 4K 1K Thunderstorm Wind (G55) What appeared to be a small but powerful downburst occurred in northern Bibb County about 5 miles west-southwest of West Blocton. Trees were downed and a couple of mobile homes sustained minor damage along with a storage shed. The damage path was slightly less than a mile long and only about 50 yards wide. **Shelby County** 2 NW Maylene 50 15K 21 0935CST 0936CST 0.5 Tornado (F0) A small tornado occurred at the Brantleyville community about 2 miles northwest of Maylene in southwest Shelby County. The tornado track was very short with a number of trees downed and damage to several frame houses in the form on shingles off. A tree **Autauga County** Autaugaville 21 0955CST 0 0 8K 0 Thunderstorm Wind (G50) The EMA reported several trees and power lines down in Autaugaville as a line of thunderstorms moved through the town. **Montgomery County** Montgomery 10K Thunderstorm Wind (G76) Numerous trees and power lines were downed in Montgomery. A wind gust to 87 mph was reported at Maxwell Air Force Base on the western side of Montgomery. Franklin County 0130CST 2KHail (0.75) Vina 27 Dime size hail was reported at Vina in western Franklin County. **Colbert County** Sheffield 0134CST 5K Thunderstorm Wind Power lines were blown down in Sheffield. ALZ024 Jefferson 27 5K 0 High Wind (G45) Several trees and power lines were knocked down by strong gradient wind. **Walker County** Flash Flood 0700CST 0800CST 0 10K Jasper 28 Heavy rain produced flash flooding in Jasper. Two to three feet of water was reported on some roads. School opening was delay one hour due to the flash flooding. **Etowah County** Gadsden 0840CST 10K Flash Flood 28 0900CST Flash flooding was reported in Gadsden and Attalla.
