ORINDA

PLANNING The City of Orinda is currently considering a range of affordable housing development opportunities near the station. BART has provided transit-oriented development case studies and information incorporated into City Council and Planning Commission workshops and presentations led by the Local Government Commission in an effort to assist with the definition of new development models for the area.

ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS The City of Orinda has recently initiated a series of pedestrian safety improvements focused on routes between the BART station and downtown Orinda.

BART staff completed installation of 26 new bike racks/lockers; 32 old racks have been removed. In addition, six of BART's new "Club" style, metal see-through bicycle lockers have been installed at the station. This station will have new, ADA-compliant platform edge tiles installed, pending the receipt of grant funds.

REINVESTMENT This station had new, energy efficient lighting fixtures and lamps installed throughout the station parking lot in 2003. This station is also scheduled to have the station canopy re-roofed in 2004 and the parking lot re-paved in 2005. These projects are all part of ongoing station renovation program activities.
