SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO INVESTIGATE PROCUREMENT AND EXPENDITURE PRACTICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM AND SELECTED ATTACHED AGENCIES.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Business, Economic Development, 2 and Tourism is charged with a wide range of responsibilities 3 that are intended to spur immediate gains as well as garner 4 long-term economic benefits for the State and Hawaii taxpayers; 5 and

WHEREAS, during the past five years, as the Legislature
considered adopting and, in some cases, rejecting various
proposals advanced by the Department of Business, Economic
Development, and Tourism to further economic development in the
State, the Legislature has also been mindful of its rationale
for its eventual decisions; and

WHEREAS, whether the proposals of the Department of 14 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism have involved the 15 High Technology Development Corporation, the High Technology 16 Innovation Corporation, the Hawaii Strategic Development 17 Corporation, overseas offices in Taipei and Beijing, energy 18 programs, various strategic marketing and enterprise zone 19 programs, and other programs of the Department, the Legislature 20 has made its decisions on the basis of the belief that related 21 public funds will be expended as the Legislature intended; and 22 23

24 WHEREAS, the Legislature also expects the Department of 25 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to adhere to the 26 Legislature's decisions when specific proposals of the 27 Department are not adopted; and

29 WHEREAS, compliance with procurement and expenditure laws 30 and with other laws that govern state employee behavior and job

performance is an unchallenged expectation for every department 1 and employee of state government; and 2 3 WHEREAS, pursuant to chapter 23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 4 the Auditor is authorized to audit "the transactions, accounts, 5 programs, and performance of all departments, offices, and 6 agencies of the State...to discover evidence of any 7 unauthorized, illegal, irregular, improper, or unsafe handling 8 9 or expenditure of state funds or other improper practice of financial administration..."; and 10 11 WHEREAS, an examination of the documents, electronic mail, 12 and other written material of the Department of Business, 13 Economic Development, and Tourism and the testimony and behavior 14 15 of witnesses and officials provided to the Legislature have raised considerable concern that standards are not being met and 16 state funds are not yielding defensible returns on investment; 17 18 now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the 21 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 22 requested to investigate procurement and expenditure practices 23 of the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism 24 25 and selected attached agencies; and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in conducting the 27 investigation, the Auditor is requested to include but not be 28 limited to a review of the High Technology Development 29 Corporation, the High Technology Innovation Corporation, the 30 Hawaii Strategic Development Corporation, and any programs and 31 entities under each respective corporation; and 32 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to investigate programs within the Department of Business, Economic 35 Development, and Tourism that include but are not limited to 36 those covering strategic marketing and support, including the 37 overseas offices, creative industries, energy and strategic 38 industries, the foreign trade zone, and general support for 39 40 economic development; and 41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 42 report findings and recommendations, including any necessary 43

1 proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty 2 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2009; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this

6 Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, the
7 Executive Directors of the High Technology Development
8 Corporation and High Technology Innovation Corporation,
9 respectively, and the President of the Hawaii Strategic
10 Development Corporation.
