## **What is the Earned Income Tax Credit?**

The Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) is a federal, state and city tax credit for low-to-moderate-income working families and individuals. The EITC can help you reduce your tax liability and, in many cases, put money in your pocket. In general, a tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar reduction of the taxes you owe. The EITC is known as a “refundable tax credit.” This means that if the amount you owe in taxes is less than the amount of the EITC, you will receive a check from the government for the difference. In the 2004 tax season, New Yorkers who claimed their EITC received an average return of nearly \$2,500.<sup>1</sup>

To qualify for the EITC, you must have worked at least part of 2006, meet certain income requirements, and file your taxes. It is very important to note that you must file your taxes to receive the EITC, even if you did not earn enough money to require you to file.

If you meet the eligibility requirements and did not file for the EITC in any one of the last few years, you may also be entitled to retroactive benefits, meaning an even larger refund check. You may be eligible to receive benefits for one or more of the preceding three (2004, 2005, 2006) calendar years.

## Are You Eligible for the Earned Income Tax Credit?

The Federal, State, and New York City governments each offer the EITC to qualified workers. If you are eligible for the Federal EITC, you are eligible for all three Earned Income Tax Credits. Depending on your earnings in 2006, filing for all three of these credits could result in a tax refund of up to about \$6,000. Your eligibility and the amount of your return depend on several factors such as your filing status, income level, and the number of qualifying children or dependents you claim. Both families and individuals are eligible to receive the EITC.

### **To be eligible to receive the EITC, you:**

1. **MUST** have earned some sort of income in 2006 through employment or self-employment;
2. **MUST** file your taxes for income earned in 2006;
3. **MUST** have a Social Security Number or a taxpayer ID number, for yourself, your spouse (if filing jointly), and any qualifying dependents;
4. **MUST** have been a U.S. citizen or resident alien for all of 2006;
5. **CANNOT** have earned investment income greater than \$2,800 for the 2006 tax year;<sup>2</sup>
6. **CANNOT** file as “married filing separately;”
7. **CANNOT** be a qualifying child;
8. **CANNOT** file Form 2555 or Form 2555-EZ.

### **Income Eligibility Requirements<sup>3</sup> and Maximum Credit Amounts<sup>4</sup>**

- Families or individuals earning less than \$12,120<sup>5</sup> (\$14,120 for married couples filing jointly) with **no children** may receive up to \$555.
- Families earning less than \$32,001 (\$34,001 for married couples filing jointly) with **one child** may receive up to \$3,708.
- Families earning less than \$36,348 (\$38,348 for married couples filing jointly) with **two or more children** may receive up to \$6,122.

## Qualification Requirements for Children<sup>5</sup>

Children must meet three requirements in order to be included in your family for the purpose of applying for the EITC. These requirements are:

1. **Residency Requirement:** All children included in an EITC family household must have lived with you for more than half of 2006.
2. **Relationship Requirement:** All children included in an EITC family household must be a son, daughter, stepchild, foster child, brother, sister, stepbrother, stepsister, or a descendant of any of the aforementioned.
3. **Age Requirement:** On December 31, 2006 all children included in your EITC-eligible family household must have been younger than 19 years old, or 24 years old if a full-time student, or any age if permanently and totally disabled.

## Qualifying Families without Children<sup>6</sup>

If you do not have any children you must meet three requirements:

- You **MUST** be at least 25, but no more than 65, years of age;
- You **CANNOT** be a qualifying dependent;
- You **MUST** have lived within the United States for more than half of 2006.

## Hurricane Victims of 2005<sup>7</sup>

Tax returns for 2005 offered the option of using earnings from 2004 to calculate EITC refunds for victims of the 2005 hurricanes Katrina, Rita, and Wilma. If your main home was in the hurricane disaster area and if your 2004 income was higher than your 2005 income—but you did not claim the EITC for 2005—check with the IRS, a VITA tax preparer, or a tax professional to see if you are eligible to file an amended return for 2005 using your 2004 income to determine the EITC.

## Combat Zone Pay<sup>8</sup>

Members of the armed services may claim their tax-exempt combat zone pay for purposes of the EITC. The claim must include all or none of the combat zone pay.

## **Bank Deposit Options for EITC Funds**

The IRS offers three ways to receive your refund. There is the traditional option of receiving it as a paper check in the mail. Alternatively, you can have it deposited directly into one checking or savings account. And you now also have the option of using direct deposit to split your refund into two or three checking or savings accounts.

### **New Split Refund Option**

This newly established “split refund option” allows you to have the refund deposited, or “split” among two or three accounts that may be in different institutions. This option is available regardless of which 1040 form (except Form 1040EZ-T, Claim for Refund of Federal Excise Tax) you use to file.

To split your refund, you must attach Form 8888, Direct Deposit of Refund to More Than One Account, to your tax return. To ensure your refund goes where you want, be sure to verify that your financial institution will accept direct deposits to your account and enter the correct account and routing numbers.

## **Beware of High Cost Commercial Tax Preparation!**

**IF YOU USE A COMMERCIAL TAX PREPARER  
DON'T SELECT A REFUND ANTICIPATION LOAN.  
IT COULD EAT UP A BIG CHUNK OF YOUR TAX REFUND!**

Each year, many commercial tax preparers charge New York City residents exorbitant fees for short-term, high interest rate loans that **save them only a little more than one week of wait time** for their tax refunds.<sup>9</sup>

The majority of Refund Anticipation Loans (RALs) (also called rapid refund or instant refund loans) enable you to leave the tax preparer's office with cash in your hand, but come with confusing fine print and fees that significantly reduce your tax refund.

RALs go overwhelmingly to residents of New York's poorest communities of color, many of whom are recipients of the EITC. A study by the Neighborhood Economic Development Advocacy Project found that from 2002 to 2005, "RALs siphoned more than \$324 million out of New York City's poorest communities."<sup>10</sup>

RALs are commonly offered by large commercial tax preparers such as H&R Block or Jackson Hewitt, which, in the past, have used aggressive sales techniques to convince tax filers to take these expensive, short-term loans.

If, for example, filing for the EITC entitles you to a refund of \$1,754, using a commercial tax preparer and taking a RAL would cut your refund to \$1,489, which amounts to a 15 percent decrease in the amount of your refund. The best way to avoid losing out on that money is to have your taxes prepared at one of the many **FREE or low-cost tax preparation sites** in New York City. If, however, you choose to use a commercial tax preparer, at least **know the facts**. On average, commercial tax preparers will charge you \$165 just to prepare your taxes, fill out EITC forms and file them electronically. If you decide to add a RAL, they will charge you, on average, another \$100 fee. That is, on average, \$265<sup>11</sup> that could have gone into your pocket.

Remember, the RAL only saves you a short wait time. If you file your taxes electronically and elect to have your refund deposited directly into your bank account, you will have your refund in 7 to 10 days.

## **Types of Free Tax Assistance in New York City**

### **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Sites (VITA)<sup>12</sup>**

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (or VITA) sites offer free volunteer-based tax assistance for working families that generally make less than \$40,000 per year and individuals who make less than \$20,000 per year. A few sites listed below have different requirements. Once you have selected the VITA site of your choice, contact the site to verify the requirements and schedule an appointment.

- Volunteers are trained by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).
- All sites should have tax experts such as certified public accountants or tax attorneys on hand.
- Please contact the VITA site of your choice to make sure all tax preparation volunteers are trained and certified by the IRS and supervised by tax professionals.

### **Tax Counseling for the Elderly Sites (TCE)<sup>13</sup>**

TCE sites provide free tax assistance for people ages 60 and older. Some sites listed below may have different age or income requirements for utilizing their service. Once you have selected the TCE site of your choice, contact the site to verify the requirements and schedule an appointment.

- All volunteers are trained by the IRS.
- All sites should have tax experts such as certified public accountants or tax attorneys on hand.
- Be sure to contact the TCE site of your choice to make sure all tax preparation volunteers are trained and certified by the IRS and supervised by tax professionals.

## **Checklist: What to Bring/Do When Filing for the EITC**

Make sure you have the following items with you and take the following steps when visiting one of the free tax services listed in this guide.<sup>14</sup>

- Photo ID**

  - E-filing your taxes with direct deposit into your bank account is the fastest way to get your return (7 – 10 days). To e-file, bring a sample check or bank account information with you when filing your taxes.
  - To open a bank account, check with a bank or credit union about a free, no-cost, no-minimum checking or savings account.

  - Contact the free tax assistance site of your choice from the list below to confirm services provided, dates, times and information required;
