ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE APPOINTED TO COMMISSION

Chairman Pat Wood, III has appointed Jeffie Janette Massey as an Administrative Law Judge for the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

Judge Massey comes to the Commission from the Social Security Administration in San Antonio, Texas, where she served as an Administrative Law Judge responsible for hearings involving claims under the Social Security Act. Prior to that, she was a public defender with the Public Defender's Office of Colorado County in Columbus, Texas. In that position she represented defendants in the County and District Courts. She also represented juvenile offenders charged with delinquent conduct. Before that Judge Massey was in private practice in Columbus where she litigated both criminal and civil proceedings at the state and federal levels. She also served as Assistant Criminal District Attorney in Canton, Texas. Prior to that, she held several positions with the U.S. Department of Energy's Economic Regulatory Administration in Dallas, Texas, including Supervisory Attorney, Deputy Chief Counsel, and Senior Attorney Advisor.

Judge Massey received her J.D. and B.A. degrees from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas.

She received the Oath of Office today and her appointment is effective immediately.
