We are oπering a class on Food Safety in Child Care which includes the option to take the test to get your Food Handler Card.

Designed for people working in child care programs, this class will cover food safety concerns in a child care setting. The training will also include all the essential components required to take the Food Handler Card test. The Food Handler Card test is offered at the end of class.

We are offering 3 different options for this class (please make checks payable to SKCDPH):

Option 1 To receive 1.5 STARS Credits <u>and</u> a Food Handler Card:

Plan to stay until 8:30 pm and send us a registration payment of \$18.

Option 2 To receive a Food Handler Card only:

Plan to stay until 8:30 pm and send us a registration payment of \$10.

Option 3 To receive 1.5 STARS credits only:

Plan to stay until 8:00 (you will not have to take the food handler test) and send us a **registration payment of \$8**.

IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

The following products have recently been recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). Cosco "Rock 'N Roller" Baby Strollers are being recalled by Dorel Juvenile Group USA because if the stop pins are bent or missing or the seat is not fully attached, the seat can partially detach from the frame during use and the infant occupant can be injured in a fall. The strollers involved have seats that can be removed from the stroller frame. The label on the back of the frame contains one of the following model numbers: "01-654, 01-622, 01-624, 01-646, 01-656." Stop using the recalled "Rock 'N Roller" strollers with detachable seats immediately and contact Dorel Juvenile Group at (800) 711-0402 or www.digusa.com to determine how to inspect the stroller for possible replacement.

Children's Swimsuit Cover-ups are being recalled by Samara Brothers, Inc. because the zipper pull on the cover-up can detach, posing a choking hazard to young children. The cover-ups were sold in various colors for boys and girls, both separately and as part of a swimsuit set. They were sold under the brand names "Samara" and "Carter's" (printed on the garment-care tag) in sizes 3 to 24 months, 2T to 4T and 4X to 6X. On the short-sleeved cover-up are various patches depicting beach and swim-related themes. Consumers should stop using these cover-ups and contact Samara Brothers at (866) 448-7758 for instructions on receiving a free repair or replacement cover-up.

Basic Editions Infant and Toddler Girls' Rompers are being recalled by Kmart Corp. because the crocheted cherry-shape tassels and plastic buttons may pull off, posing a choking hazard to young children. Sold at Kmart stores, the recalled rompers are pink and white gingham with pink buttons and crocheted cherry-shape tassels on the pocket and green and white gingham bows on the trim of the leg openings. Return the rompers to the Kmart store where purchased for a refund.

Old Navy Children's Zippered Outerwear is being recalled because the plastic zipper pull can detach from the zipper, posing a choking hazard to young children. The recall involves children's outerwear garments with a clear, oval-shaped zipper pull. Sold in sizes 6 months to 4T, the garments have one of the following style numbers on a label under the garment-care tag: 210209, 210210, 210211, 210212, 210672, 210673, 210228. Return the garments to any Old Navy store for a refund and a complimentary \$5 appreciation card.

Land of Nod® Children's Wooden Chairs are being recalled because the leg supports can crack, causing the chair to collapse. The chairs have either a round or straight back and a lacquer painted finish in red, light blue, dark blue, pale yellow or light green. A sticker under the seat reads either "Made in PROC" or "Made in China" and the chairs are about 26-inches high. Stop using these chairs and contact The Land of Nod at (866) 990-5263 or www.landofnod.com/recall for instructions on returning the chairs.

Payless ShoeSource Smart Fit™ and Teeny Toes™ Athletic Shoes are being recalled because the metal eyelet lace holder at the top of the shoes can detach, posing a choking hazard to young children. The shoes are white with colored trim and come in prewalk and toddler sizes 0 – 10. The brand name "Smart Fit" or "Teeny Toes" is written on the sole and insole of the shoes. Return the shoes to a Payless ShoeSource store for a cash refund or exchange.
