IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

The following products have recently been recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). "Jack in the Box" type toys are being recalled by Schylling Associates Inc. because the bead on the crank of the toy can detach, posing a choking hazard to young children. Two designs of the "Jack-In-The-Box" type toys are included in this recall, both of which play "Pop Goes the Weasel" when the crank is turned. One is based on Dr. Seuss' Cat in the Hat ("CAT IN THE HAT" is written on the box lid), and the other is based on Ian Falconer's Olivia the pig character ("CIRCUS" is written around the top sides of the box). Schylling Associates, Inc. has already recalled a Bear "Jack-In-The-Box" type toy in November because of the same hazard. The toys were sold nationwide from June 2003 through November 2003 for about \$25. Consumers should take these toys away from children immediately and contact Schylling Associates, Inc. at (800) 767-8697 or www.schylling.com for information on receiving a refund or replacement toy.





FREE BOOSTER SEAT MATERIALS AND DISCOUNT COUPONS AVAILABLE

Encourage the families you serve to buckle their older children in booster seats! It's the law in Washington for children between 4-6 years or 40-60 pounds to use booster seats when riding in motor vehicles. Doctors and safety experts at the Harborview Injury Prevention and Research Center and Seattle Children's Hospital and Regional Medical Center recommend that all children over 40 pounds use booster seats until the lap and shoulder belt fits right. Typically, seat belts fit correctly when children are 4'9" tall, around 80 pounds and 8 years old.

They offer these safety tips for parents of older children:

- Start to use a booster seat when your child outgrows his forward-facing car seat at 40 pounds.
- Never put the shoulder belt behind a child's back or under an arm. Without the shoulder belt, your child's body will fly forward in a crash.
- Never use just a lap belt across a child sitting in a booster seat.
- Never use pillows, books, or towels to boost a child. These can slide out from under the child in a crash.
- All children under 13 years old should sit properly restrained in the back seat.

The Booster Seat Coalition has brochures, posters in English and Spanish, information sheets in 14 different languages, and discount coupons for booster seats available. The coupons will provide a \$5 discount on any Cosco booster sold at Target stores throughout Washington. No-back booster seats will now cost less than \$15, and a high-back booster seat will cost under \$25. Offered by the Washington State Booster Seat Coalition, the coupons are good through July 31, 2004.


