IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

The following products have recently been recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). For more information on these and other recalled products, please visit the CPSC web site at www.cpsc.gov and click on "Recalls/news," or call the CPSC hotline at 1-800-638-2772.

Merit Bunk Beds are being recalled by Merit Furniture Distributors, Inc. because the beds have openings between the guardrails and in the end structures that are too large. A child could slide between the openings and become trapped posing a serious strangulation hazard. Bunk beds being recalled are models #DLM550, #DLM160, and #860. Contact Merit at (800) 233-1778 or visit www.meritfurnitureistributors.com for information on returning the bunk beds for a full refund.

Plan Toys Solid Drums are being recalled by BRIO Corp. because the three rubber feet, which are screwed into the bottom of the drum, could be removed, posing a choking hazard to young children. The natural wood drum is 6¼ inches in diameter by 3 inches high with blue and red triangles painted on the side. The inside flap of the packaging has lot number 46271068, 1546214 or 4345141. Take the recalled drums away from young children immediately and contact BRIO at (888) 274-6869 or www.Briotoy.com for a refund or replacement product.

Fisher-Price Electric Scooters and Electric Mini Bikes are being recalled because the motor control circuits can malfunction causing the scooters and mini bikes to continue to run after the power or throttle button is released, posing a risk of injury to children. The recalled Lightning PAC Scooters and MX3 Mini Bikes are battery powered ride-on toys designed for children ages six years and older. They have model numbers of 73530 (Lightning PAC) or 73535 and B2222 (MX3 Mini Bike), which can be found inside the battery compartment. Take the toy vehicles away from children immediately and contact Fisher-Price at (800) 528-7153 or www.service.mattel.com for information on how to have the toys serviced for free at a certified Power Wheels Service Center.

DesignWare Crazy Bounce Balls are being recalled by American Greetings Corp. because the balls could break apart, posing a choking hazard to young children. The 1½ inch multi-colored cluster of green, light green and brick red rubber balls have Model Number CBB1306 and UPC 61526 72866 written on the back of their light green cardboard packaging. Take these balls away from young children and contact American Greetings Corp. at (800) 777-4891 or <http://corporate.americangreetings.com> for a redeemable coupon.

DesignWare Zipper Pulls are being recalled by American Greetings Corp. because the product could separate and detach from the zipper, posing a choking hazard to young children. The zipper pull is a 2-inch plastic blue or purple butterfly-shaped photo holder that can be attached to a zipper. Consumers should dispose of the zipper pulls immediately and contact American Greetings Corp. at (800) 777-4891 or <http://corporate.americangreetings.com> for a redeemable coupon.

Amazing Baby Listen and Play Activity Books are being recalled by Advantage Publishers Group because the hub of the pink dial embedded in the inside back cover can come off during use, posing a choking hazard to young children. The book has a multi-colored cover with a baby face on the front, as well as a yellow bird that makes a squeak noise when pressed. Consumers should take these books away from young children immediately and contact Advantage Publishers Group at (866) 748-3731 or www.advantagebooksonline.com to order a replacement.

Multi-colored and Solid-colored Sidewalk Chalk is being recalled by Agglo Corp. and Toys "R" Us, Inc. because it contains high levels of lead, posing a risk of poisoning to young children. Sold at Toys "R" Us stores, the chalk is packaged in a clear-plastic backpack-type carrying case with these words on the label: "Chalk to Go...Totally Me!...24 pieces, sidewalk chalk in different colors, fun chalk shapes." Return the sidewalk chalk to Toys "R" Us for a refund.

Multi-colored Sidewalk Chalk is also being recalled by Agglo Corp. and Target because of high lead levels which pose a risk of poisoning to young children. The multi-colored chalk is sold in a package labeled "Double Dipp'n Fun" and should be returned to Target stores for a refund.
