2007 Class Fees

Our goal is to provide quality training for child care providers at a reasonable cost. Where possible we seek grant funding to underwrite a portion of training costs. Effective January 1, 2007 class fees will be \$10 per person per hour. A 2 credit STARS class will cost \$20 per person. All First Aid and Bloodborne Pathogens/HIV/AIDS classes will also be \$20.

Class Registration Information

Pre-registration is required for all classes. To register, please mail the registration form on page 7. **Classes fill quickly so send in the registration form and payment as soon as possible.** We do not accept registrations by telephone. Please make your check payable to: <u>SKCDPH</u> (Seattle – King County Department of Public Health) & return the registration form with payment to:

If you have any questions, please call (206) 296-2770. Space is limited. Please register early or call us at (206) 296-2770 to check for class openings. If a class fills before we receive your registration, your check will be returned to you. If a money order or cashier's check is used as payment, we will issue a refund. To avoid disrupting the class, and to receive full credit, please try to arrive on time. We also request that you make other child care arrangements so that your attention can be focused on the class.

Our Class Cancellation Policy

- If we cancel a class (due to low enrollment, snow, or other reason) you may choose between receiving a refund or a credit toward another class.
- If you register for a class and find you cannot attend, please notify us at (206) 296-2770 at least 24 hours before the class. No refunds will be made, but if you notify us at least 24 hours before the class you will be eligible for a credit toward another class.

Designed for people working in child care programs, this class will cover food safety concerns in a child care setting. The training will also include all the essential components required to take the Food Handler Card test. The Food Handler Card test is offered at the end of class.

Option 1 To receive 1.5 STARS Credits and a Food Handler Card:

Plan to stay until 8:30 and send us a registration payment of \$20.

Option 3 To receive 1.5 STARS credits only:

Plan to stay until 8:00 (you will not have to take the food handler test) and send us a

Playing Outside in Northwest Weather

The Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 388-295-2130 1 requires child care facilities to provide outdoor playtime activities for all children in their programs. This means that even in the rain, children need to go outside and play!



Remember, your child doesn't get sick from playing outside in the rain. Colds are caused by viruses, not wet clothes, so it's safe for children to play in the rain.



Of course, getting wet is uncomfortable, so bring rain gear (including boots if possible) and a change of clothes for your child.

Encourage children to be active outdoors. Playing in the sun or rain helps them develop emotionally, socially and physically. It's also fun, so encourage physical activity even in rain.
