We are offering a new class on Food Safety in Child Care which includes the option to take the test to get your Food Handler Card.

When: Tuesday, June 8 from 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM

Where: Denise Louie Education Center 3327 Beacon Ave. South, Seattle

Designed for people working in child care programs, this class will cover food safety concerns in a child care setting. The training will also include all the essential components required to take the Food Handler Card test. The Food Handler Card test will be offered at the end of the class.

### We are offering 3 different options for this class:

Option 1 To receive 1.5 STARS Credits <u>and</u> a Food Handler Card:

Plan to stay until 8:30 pm and send us a registration payment of \$18.

Option 2 To receive a Food Handler Card only:

Plan to stay until 8:30 pm and send us a registration payment of \$10.

Option 3 To receive 1.5 STARS credits only:

Plan to stay until 8:00 (you will not have to take the food handler test) and send us a **registration payment of \$8**.

### IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

The following products have recently been recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC). Radio-Control Toy Trucks are being recalled by Nikko America Inc. because a problem with the circuit board causes the toy truck to overheat, posing a fire and burn hazard. The recalled trucks are approximately 18 inches in length and have one of the following model numbers on the body of the truck: 100021A, 100022A 100022B, 100023A, 100023B, 100024A, or 100024B. Major toy and discount department stores sold the trucks from July 2003 through February 2004 for about \$60. Consumers should stop using the toy trucks and contact Nikko America toll-free at (866) 232-6013 or <a href="https://www.nikkoamerica.com/recall">www.nikkoamerica.com/recall</a>.

BATMAN™ BATMOBILE™ Toy Vehicle is being recalled by Mattel Inc. because the rear tail wings of the Batmobile™ are made of rigid plastic and come to a point, posing a potential puncture or laceration hazard to young children. The toy is a 20-inch blue and gray plastic vehicle with a detachable motorcycle. Model number B4944 is written on the bottom of the toy. Consumers should take these toys away from children immediately and contact Mattel at (888) 271-9891 or <a href="https://www.service.mattel.com">www.service.mattel.com</a> to receive a free replacement wing repair kit.

**Ride-On Toys** are being recalled by Tek Nek Toys International, L.P. because the screw and nut assembly attaching the steering wheel can come loose, posing a choking and aspiration hazard to young children. The ride-on toys were sold for about \$30 under five model names including Butterfly Girl, Fire Rescue, Mermaid, Police Car and Tonka Construction Crew. The toys can be used as a ride-on or push walker toy, with a handle on the back of the seat rest. On the dash of the toys are buttons which produce sounds when activated. Sold for children age 1 to 3 years old, the toys have a date code from 20021127 to 20030319 located in the battery compartment on the top panel next to the steering wheel. Consumers should take these recalled ride-on toy vehicles away from young children immediately and contact Tek Nek Toys at (888) 661-0222 or <a href="www.teknektoys.com">www.teknektoys.com</a> to receive free replacement parts.

**Children's Mirror Books** are being recalled by Kids II Inc. because the mirror in the books can crack or break, posing a laceration hazard to young children. The recalled picture books are brightly colored, made of flexible vinyl, and contain a plastic mirror on one of the inside pages. The recalled books come in four models: "Baby's Fun Book," "Baby's Photo Album," "Picture This Vinyl Book," and "Carter's Imagination Picture Book." Consumers should take the books away from children immediately and detach and mail the mirror page of the product to Kids II at 1015 Windward Ridge Parkway, Alpharetta, GA 30005 for a refund.

**Bunk Beds** made by Ashley Furniture Industries, Inc. are being recalled for repairs because there are gaps between parts of the bunk bed that violate federal safety standards and can be entrapment or strangulation hazards to children. These bunk bed models are recalled for repairs: B383-58T, B383-57T, B213-58, and B233-58. The model numbers are on product stickers on each bunk bed. Consumers should stop using the bunk beds and contact the dealer who sold the bunk bed for a free repair kit.
