Emergency Preparedness for Child Care Providers: Excellence Award Series

This class is designed for both child care center providers and family child care home providers. The City of Bellevue Fire Department and Public Health – Seattle & King County have joined together to provide a series of 4 classes designed to help child care providers develop a comprehensive disaster plan. The series will teach child care providers how to plan for taking care of children and staff for an extended time due to severe weather or a disaster. Topics will include: writing the emergency plan, maximizing staff for effective emergency response, what and how much supplies you need, educating and recruiting parent volunteers, parent/child reunion, and effective drills. Participants will leave with sample forms and an organizational plan for response.

Participants completing the program and homework assignments will be eligible to apply for the "Excellence Award for Child Care Programs."

Each class is \$16 and earns 2.5 STARS credits. The series of 4 classes is \$64 and offers 10 STARS credits. It is recommended that you attend all of the classes (a program must have at least 1 staff person at each class in order to be eligible for the Excellence Award).

Immunizations Keep Children Safe and Healthy

Public Health – Seattle & King County is urging families to make sure all children's immunizations are up to date. The law requires that children have current immunizations before attending a child care program.

"Immunizations are a very safe and effective way to keep our children and communities healthy," said King County Executive Ron Sims. "Outbreaks can disrupt classes and keep children out of school," said Dr. Alonzo Plough, Director of Public health – Seattle & King County. "However, with current immunizations for our school children, outbreaks are preventable."

Parents or legal guardians have the right to choose not to immunize their children, based on medical, religious or philosophical reasons. Parents or legal guardians must sign the appropriate box on the Certificate of Immunization Status form to exempt their child from receiving vaccines required for child care entry. There are significant risks, however, when choosing against vaccination.

"Delaying vaccinations or not vaccinating puts children and others in the community at increased risk for preventable and potentially serious infections," said Dr. Jeff Duchin, Chief of Public Health's Communicable Disease, Epidemiology and Immunization Section. "In addition to the risk of becoming infected with a vaccine-preventable disease, a child who is not fully immunized may be excluded from attending school or child care during an outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease and can spread the infection to others."

IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

Schwinn Toddler Bicycle Helmets are being recalled by PTI Sports Inc. because they do not meet Consumer Product Safety requirements. The helmets have "SCHWINN" on the back and a label inside reads, "Lot# 791913," followed by a date from "12-01-03" through "5-15-04." They were sold at Wal-Mart, Target, and other stores nationwide from Jan. 2004 through July 2004. Return the recalled helmet to the store where purchased for a replacement or refund or mail it to the PTI Sports (800-515-0074).

Red Chairs are being recalled by Meco Corp. because the red paint on the chair contains excessive lead levels, posing a lead poisoning hazard to young children. The red folding chair with metal frame and vinyl padded seat back and base was sold as part of a five-piece child's table furniture set. Only red chairs with model numbers 11-88-3E1 and 11-88S3E1 and date codes H3, B4, D4 or E4 printed underneath the seat bottom are included in the recall. Stop using this red chair and contact Meco Corp. at (800) 251-7558 or www.meco.net for instructions on returning the chair for a free replacement.

Nike "GET-GO" and "LITTLE GET-GO" Children's Athletic Shoes are being recalled by Nike because the 1.5-inch to 1.75-inch rubber tab at the top of the heel can detach from the shoe, posing a choking hazard to young children. The shoes were sold in toddler and pre-school sizes 2C through 3Y from June 2004 through August 2004 for between \$35 and \$45. The shoes have one of the following numbers on a label inside the shoe just above the UPC code: 308638, 308639, 308642, and 308647.
