**DECISION AND ORDER**

This is a proceeding under the H-1B provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, ("INA"), 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b) and the applicable regulations issued there under at 29 C.F.R. Part 507. The Administrator, United States Department of Labor, Wage and Hour Division ("Administrator") and Professional Surgical Services d/b/a/ Valta Industries, Inc. ("Respondent" or "Valta"), have filed Consent Findings resolving all issues in dispute in this case relating to Valta's contest of the Administrator's findings regarding its compliance with the H-1B provisions of the INA. The Consent Findings are marked for identification as ALJ No. 1, and are attached hereto and made a part hereof.
