SUPPLEMENTAL DECISION AND ORDER

By Decision and Order dated December 16, 1982, the plaintiff's request for a variance from the housing regulations set forth at 20 C.F.R. §654.400 et seq. was denied.

By letter dated January 10, 1983, the plaintiff requested consideration of additional facts which it submitted to this Office at that time. In a subsequent letter dated January 31, 1983, the plaintiff advised this Office that the Regional Office representative of the Employment and Training Administration (ETA) had notified the plaintiff that compliance with the regulation could be achieved by installation of a bunk bed and a single bed in the room of 144 square feet. The plaintiff has agreed to make these changes.

It therefore appears that the plaintiff, Vosburgh Orchards, has reached an accommodation with the defendant, ETA, and hence, no further action in this matter is required by this Office.


