Subject: Unemployment Compensation (UC) Charges

Attached is the prorated share of UC charges for each bureau. The Department of Labor (DOL) billing for April, May, and June (FY 2007) was allocated to each bureau based on percentages obtained from the contractor's match of actual state charges with Department of the Interior payroll records for the period October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2006.
