ISA Workgroup discussion		
Jill Archer and Mary Rumbaugh –		
Reviewed "Top of the Pyramid" handout		
(green sheet) The following statements are		
key points from the presentation/discussion:		
-The group reviewed 55 children.		
-Each MHO identified their own children		
The number of times the child was moved		
seemed to be the strongest indicator.		
-Boarderline IQ #'s also seemed high. Want		
to have workgroup review.		

-Number of days in-patient was significant. -Was the size of the MHO taken into account? -Plans were not limited to 10 to 12 clients reviewed. 10 to 12 was the average reviewed? -PRTS as a marker was identified as being at the bottom of the pyramid. PRTS reflected both similarities and differences in their care. -Identified which agencies were responsible for what, with respect to each child. -Can interventions be targeted to prevent kids from raising to top of the pyramid? -Work with Child Welfare partners. -What is the difference between these kids and other ISA kids that have had a more stable environment? -How much are kids costing? (Will workgroups have access to this data from Plan to Plan?) Data may not reflect fairly. Get larger Plans to submit more kids than the smaller ones for the same percentage represented for each. Also, look at the bottom of the pyramid, and draw differences between the two groups. Contact Audit & Evaluation Unit to determine an appropriate sample for each plan. What will this data be used for? *Analize the data in order to do targeted intervention so kids do not become the top of the pyramid kids. *The original intentions were to bring the
